Situation Report No. 65 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 1 June 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,881 new cases bringing total cases to 87,142. Of the new cases, 37% were Saudis, 28% were females and 11% were children.
- 1,864 new recoveries, bringing total to 64,306.
- 22 new mortalities bringing total to 525. Mortalities were in Makkah, Jeddah, Dammam, Tabuk and Salil; age range 42-93.
- There are 22,311 active cases, 461 of them in critical condition.
- 15,854 PCR tests were conducted, reaching a total of 838,623.
- The MoH Call Centre "937" has announced the first stage of implementing the Sign Language Service through the "Eshara" application for people with hearing loss.
- Productive families make available cloth masks to meet the huge demand.
- Any passenger with temperature above 38°C will be denied entry into airports.
- Haramain high speed train will be back on track in September.
- WHO released two new documents: key planning recommendations for mass gatherings in the context of COVID-19; and, technical guidance for the prevention and control of COVID-19 across long-term care services (see links below).
- WHO lists all candidate COVID-19 vaccines in various stages of development without endorsing any of them (see link below).

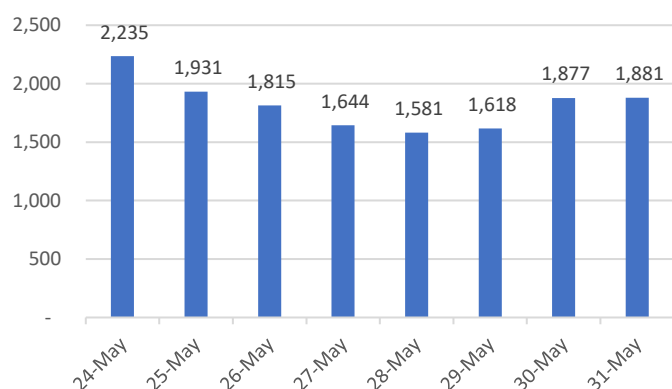

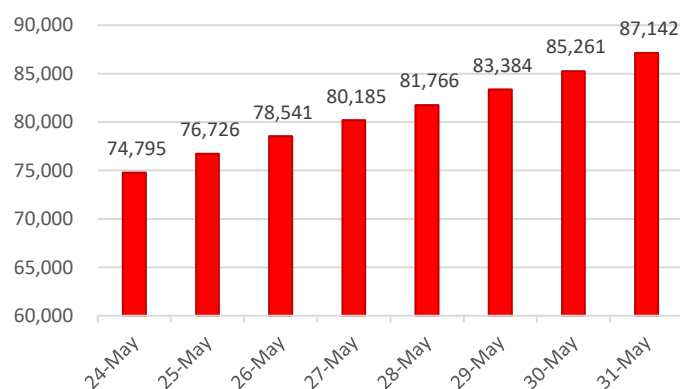
