
WEEKLY AWD/CHOLERA SITUATION REPORT - SOMALIA

Epidemiological Week 15 (6 to 12 April 2020)


Highlights

- During week 15 a total of 140 new cases of cholera and 1 death were reported from 16 districts of Banadir, Jowhar district and 3 districts of Hiran regions. No case was reported from other areas
- Since December 2017, a total of 12 741 cumulative cases, including 64 deaths (CFR 0.5%), were reported from three (3) states of Somalia (Hirshabelle, Jubbaland and South West state) and Banadir region
- Since December 2017 a cumulative attack rate of 284 cases per 100 000 population was reported, with Kismayo (Jubbaland) and Daynile (Banadir) districts being the most affected districts
- Though the overall case-fatality rate (CFR) was 0.5%, higher rates were observed in Abdilaziz, Karan and Kurtunwarey districts exceeding the WHO's threshold of <1% case fatality rate
- Of the 1 413 stool samples tested for culture since December 2017, 380 samples were tested positive for Vibrio cholerae serotype Ogawa
- Culture and sensitivity tests performed at the central public health laboratory in Mogadishu, show that the isolated Vibrio cholerae, O1, serotype Ogawa is sensitive to chloramphenicol and tetracycline but resistant to ampicillin and nalidixic acid




Cholera cases ,deaths and Case fatality rates by state of Somalia, December 2017 to 12 April. 2020

Somalia

140 new cases of cholera and **1** deaths were reported during week **15**, of which **104** (**74.2%**) were children under **5** years of age

12 741 cumulative cases including 64 deaths were reported since December 2017 when the outbreak began, of which 8 071 (63.3%) were children under 5 years of age and 6 163 (48.3%) cases were females

2 880 cumulative cases of cholera and five (14) deaths have been reported in 2020
