## **WEEKLY CHOLERA/AWD SITUATION REPORT - SOMALIA**

Epidemiological Week 15 (10-16 April 2023)





## **Highlights**

- Somalia has had uninterrupted cholera transmission in 28 droughtaffected districts since 2022 and in Banadir region since the drought period of 2017.
- During week 15, 867 new suspected cases with two associated deaths were reported from 28 drought-affected districts. The number of cholera cases reported in all districts increased by 37% with new outbreaks reported in Luuq and Dolow districts of Jubaland state (Table 1).
- Since epidemiological week 1 of 2023, a total of 5529 suspected cases of cholera including 17 associated deaths (CFR 0.3%) were reported from 28 districts of Somalia.
- The overall case fatality rate (CFR) of 0.3% reported from 28 droughtaffected districts is below the emergency threshold of ≥1%. However, the CFR of 2.9% was reported in Dolow district in week 15.
- Since epidemiological week 1, 2023 a cumulative attack rate (CAR) of 130 cases per 100 000 population was reported. Belethawa (1495 cases per 100,000), Afmadow (902 cases per 100,000), Daynile (278 cases per 100,000) and Kismayo (315 cases per 100,000) have reported the highest CAR amongst all the affected districts (Table 2).
- Of the 795 stool samples collected since epidemiological week 1 2023, 22 (2.8%) stool sample were tested positive for Vibrio cholerae 01 serotype Ogawa.
- WHO and health partners have scaled up implementation of cholera response interventions in drought affected districts focussing on Jubaland state which is the current epicentre of the current outbreak.


