WEEKLY CHOLERA/AWD SITUATION REPORT - SOMALIA

Epidemiological Week 33 (14-20 August 2023)




Highlights

- Somalia has had uninterrupted cholera transmission in 28 drought- affected districts since 2022 and in Banadir region since the drought of 2017.
- During week 33, 232 new suspected cases with no associated death were reported from 28 drought-affected districts. The number of reported cholera cases in all districts reduced by 43% in the past two months. (Table 1).
- Since epidemiological week 1 of 2023, a total of 12374 suspected cases of cholera including 30 associated deaths (CFR 02%) were reported from 28 districts of Somalia.
- The overall case fatality rate (CFR) of 0.2% reported from 28 drought-affected districts is below the emergency threshold of ≥1%.
- Since epidemiological week 1, 2023 a cumulative attack rate (CAR) of 290 cases per 100 000 population was reported. Belethawa (2863 cases per 100,000), Afmadow (1036 cases per 100,000 Dolow (1437 cases per 100,000) and Daynile (816 cases per 100,000) have reported the highest CAR amongst all the affected districts (Table 2).
- Of the 1676 stool samples collected since epidemiological week 1 2023, 534 (33.5%) samples tested positive by Rapid Diagnostic Kit (RDT) while 174 (10.9%) stool samples were tested positive for Vibrio cholerae 01 serotype Ogawa.
- WHO and health partners implemented ré-active single dose oral cholera vaccination campaign in which 535789 (90.8%) of the targeted populations were vaccinated in five districts bordering Kenya and Ethiopia in Jubaland state.


