WEEKLY CHOLERA/AWD SITUATION REPORT - SOMALIA Epidemiological Week 39 (25 September - 1 October 2023)




Highlights


- Somalia has had uninterrupted cholera transmission in 29 droughtaffected districts since 2022 and in Banadir region since the drought of 2017.
- During week 39, 223 new suspected cases with two associated deaths were reported from 29 drought-affected districts. The number of new cases increased by 20% in all districts and by almost two-fold in Burhakaba in the past two weeks. (Table 1).
- Since epidemiological week 1 of 2023, a total of 13652 suspected cases of cholera including 35 associated deaths (CFR 0.3%) were reported from 29 districts of Somalia.
- The overall case fatality rate (CFR) of 0.3% reported from 29 drought-affected districts is below the emergency threshold of ≥1%.
- Since epidemiological week 1, 2023 a cumulative attack rate (CAR) of 305 cases per 100 000 population was reported. Belethawa (3010 cases per 100,000), Afmadow (1036 cases per 100,000 Dolow (1437 cases per 100,000) and Daynile (909 cases per 100,000) have reported the highest CAR amongst all the affected districts (Table 2).
- Of the 2116 stool samples collected since epidemiological week 1 2023, 585 (27.6%) samples tested positive by Rapid Diagnostic Kit (RDT) while 203 (10.0%) stool samples were tested positive for Vibrio cholerae 01 serotype Ogawa while one sample from Afmadow tested positive for Vibrio cholerae 01 Inaba.
- WHO and health partners are scaling up the implementation of cholera preparedness and response activities in anticipation for flash floods resulting from El Nino season expected to start in October 2023.


