WEEKLY CHOLERA/AWD SITUATION REPORT - SOMALIA Epidemiological Week 9 (27 February-5 March 2023)




Highlights


- Somalia has had uninterrupted cholera transmission in 26 droughtaffected districts since 2022 and in Banadir region since the drought period of 2017.
- During week 9. 328 new suspected cases with one associated death were reported from 26 drought-affected districts. The number of cholera cases reported in Kismavo decreased by 51% while in Belethawo the new cases reported remained constant over the past two weeks (Table 1).
- Since epidemiological week 1 of 2023, a total of 2172 suspected cases of cholera including five associated deaths (CFR 0.2%) were reported from 26 districts of Somalia
- The overall case fatality rate (CFR) of 0.2% was reported from 26 droughtaffected districts which is below the emergency threshold of $\geq 1\%$.
- Since epidemiological week 1, 2023 a cumulative attack rate (CAR) of 53 cases per 100 000 population was reported. Belethawa (341 per 100.000). Afmadow (194 per 100.000). Davnile (160 per 100.000 cases). Kismayo (174 per 100,000) and Dharkenley (127 per 100 000 cases) districts have reported the highest CAR amongst all the affected districts (Table 2).
- Of the 531 stool samples collected since epidemiological week 1 2023. 20 (3.8%) stool sample were tested positive for Vibrio cholerae 01 serotype Ogawa. Eight samples collected from Elberde district where tested negative for Vibrio cholerge.
- AWD/Cholera alerts from Wanlaweyne, ELberde, Qoryoley districts (SouthWest state) and Warsheik district (Hirshabelle) were investigated and were classified as false since stool samples collected were tested negative for Vibrio Cholerae.
- WHO and health partners have scaled up implementation of cholera response interventions in Kismavo. Belethawo and other drought affected districts.


