



## TB situation in the Region, Regional profile




**TB notification rate, Sudan**




**TB notification rate Somalia**



**TB notification rate Morocco**






### **Age and sex distribution**


The notification rate of smear positive pulmonary tuberculosis is generally higher in older age groups and in males compared to females. Among the high burden countries, it shows a peak in the older age group in male in Afghanistan, Pakistan, Iraq, Sudan and Somalia but in Djibouti and Morocco, the peak was higher among younger males.




**Notified new smear-positive cases per age groups and sex,  
Djibouti, 2010**




**Notified new smear-positive cases per age groups
