


Highlights:

❖ 1 AWD was detected in Rural Damascus.

Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting


The overall completeness of reporting was 64%; (539 out of total 840 EWARS sentinel sites). (See Graph 1). 14 governorates have reported this week.




❖ Timeliness of reporting is 55%.

The Morbidity Cases


- Out of the 168,528 total consultations, a total of 17,073 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 6,265 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (37%) 5,498 cases were Influenza like Illness (32%), 738 cases of AJS, 155 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, 155 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 37 cases of Suspected Measles, 30 cases of Meningitis, 5 cases of AFP and 1 AWD case.
- Graphs 2 and 3 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 year age groups respectively






- ❖ ILI constitutes (34.72%) of the cases among <5 and (30.40%) among \geq 5, while AD constitutes (48.99%) among < 5 and (27.90%) among \geq 5.
- ❖ 56% of the cases were among males. 58% of the cases were among≥ 5 age group.
- ❖ Graph 4 displays the trend of the (23,748) AJS cases between wk1-wk24/2015. The distribution of the cases per governorates shows that Damascus, Rural Damascus, and Idleb, have the highest number of cases for this week.



- ❖ In total, 4,189 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were: 487 cases of Leishmaniasis (most of which were reported from Hamah 64%, Idleb 15%, and Damascus 11%), 205 cases of Brucellosis (most of which were reported from Rural Damascus 40%, Damascus 22% and DierEzor 17%), 146 cases of Typhoid (most of which were reported from DierEzor 42% and Rural Damascus 28%), 43 cases of Pertussis, and 20 cases of TB.
- Graph 5 and 6 below show the trend analysis of Brucellosis cases reported from all governorates and the distribution of cases per governorates respectively. It shows that Rural Damascus, Damascus, and DierEzor have the highest number of cases this week.

The Response

Acute flaccid paralysis: Stool samples were collected from the AFP cases and sent to the reference lab in Damascus. Last Polio national vaccination campaign was implemented between 31st May and 4thJune. The annualized AFP rate is 3.2 up to this week.

Acute Watery Diarrhoea: the case was managed properly, no samples were taken.

Bloody Diarrhoea: no samples have been collected from the detected cases in DeirEzore due to access problems.

Measles: Blood samples have been collected from some cases and sent to the reference lab in Damascus.

Brucellosis: Several meetings with the Ministry of Agriculture have been conducted to discuss collaborative control efforts. A guideline on Brucellosis case management have been developed in cooperation with WHO, and distributed to all brucellosis treatment centres in all governorates.

Meningitis: Meningitis cases detected are not clustered. Cases were managed according to the national protocol; and investigation forms were filled for some cases but not all; it shows that most of the cases are viral meningitis not bacterial. Preventive therapy was provided as necessary for contacts of the probable bacterial meningitis.
