

Highlights:


- ❖ (2) AFP cases were detected: (1) in Deir-ez-Zor, and (1) in Homs. Of concern is the highly suspected case detected in Deir-ez-Zor with only one dose of polio vaccine. Sending the lab samples to the reference lab in Damascus was hindered due to security situation.
- ❖ (72) Suspected Measles cases were reported during this week: from As-Sweida (18), Damascus (13), Ar-Raqqa (11), and Rural Damascus (10).

Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting

The overall completeness of reporting was 80%, (897 out of total 1122 EWARS sentinel sites), (14) Governorates have reported this week. Timeliness of reporting was 78%.

The Morbidity Cases


- Out of the 219,520 total consultations, a total of 18,530 EWARS notifiable cases are reported; of which 10,217 cases were Influenza like Illness (55%), 4,824 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (26%), 343 cases of AJS, 97 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 72 cases of Suspected Measles, 41 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, 13 cases of Suspected Meningitis, and 2 cases of Acute Flaccid Paralysis.
- Graphs 1 and 2 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 year age groups respectively.

- ❖ AD constitutes (27.77%) among < 5 and (24.63%) among ≥ 5, while ILI constitutes (56.56%) of the cases among <5 and (53.99%) among \ge 5.
- ❖ 50.6% of the cases were distributed among males, 56% of the cases were distributed among≥5 age group. In total 2,921 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 479 cases of Leishmaniasis (most of which were reported from Hama 33%, Idleb 53%, Aleppo 4%, Ar-Raqqa 6%), 156 cases of Typhoid (most of which were reported from DierEzor 38%, Hama 13%, and Rural Damascus 13%), 89 cases of Brucellosis, 28 cases of Pertussis, and 8 cases of TB.

Graph 3 shows the trend analysis of suspected Measles cases reported between week 1 and week 16 of 2016 and 2017. It shows a slight decrease in reported SM cases for this week.



Graph 4 shows the distribution of Suspected Measles cases per governorates reported during week 16 of 2017.



❖ The Response

Acute flaccid paralysis: The stool samples collected from the AFP case reported in Homs was sent to the reference lab in Damascus while the sample collected from the case detected in Deir-ez-Zor could not be sent to the reference lab due to the security situation. So far, laboratory test for AFP cases detected in previous weeks showed negative results for Polio. The annualized AFP rate up to week 16 is 3.3.

Suspected Measles cases: Measles investigation forms were filled and blood samples were collected from some suspected cases to be sent to the reference lab in Damascus.

A national vaccination campaign will be implemented during May targeting children under 5 years old.
