
Syria: The PH&CCD Directorates-MOH & WHO

Highlights:

- ❖ (3) AFP cases were reported during this week, (2) cases from Damascus, (1) case from Aleppo
- ❖ (62) Suspected Measles cases were reported during this week: from Ar-Raqqa (15), Damascus (13), Deirez-Zor (15), and Dar'a (5).

Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting


The overall completeness of reporting was 75%, (910 out of total 1132 EWARS sentinel sites), (14) Governorates have reported this week; Timeliness of reporting was 85%.




The Morbidity Cases

- Out of the 197,889 total consultations, a total of 16,223 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 6,526 cases were Influenza like Illness (33%), 6,749 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (34%), 412 cases of AJS, 54 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 62 cases of Suspected Measles, 83 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, 34 cases of Suspected Meningitis, and 3 cases of Acute Flaccid Paralysis.
- Graphs 1 and 2 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 year age groups respectively.




- ❖ AD constitutes (46.54%) among < 5 and (38%) among ≥ 5, while ILI constitutes (38.68%) of the cases among <5 and (41%) among \geq 5.
- ❖ 50% of the cases were distributed among males, 57% of the cases were distributed among≥5 age group. In total 2,300 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 430 cases of Leishmaniasis (most of which were reported from Idleb 56%, Hama 24%), 204 cases of Typhoid (most of which were reported from Deir-Ez-Zor 39%, Idleb 36%, and Rural Damascus 8%), 190 cases of Brucellosis, 30 cases of Mumps, 35 cases of Pertussis, and 21 cases of TB.

Graph 3 shows the trend analysis of suspected Measles cases reported between week 1 and week 24 of 2016 and 2017. It shows a slight increase in reported SM cases.




Graph 4: shows the distribution of Suspected Measles cases per governorates reported during week 24 of 2017.

***** The Response

cVDPV2 response: The planned response of the two rounds of immunization campaigns of (mOPV2) has been delayed due to operational and logistic issues. The new date for the first round is set to be on 22th of July and the second within 2 weeks of the 1st round.

Tuberculosis response: The Syrian Arab Red Crescent had notified about unavailability of TB medicines in the besieged area Al- Ghouta in Rural Damascus. WHO with collaboration with MoH and SARC managed to provide Al- Ghouta with TB medicines for the treatment of 79 confirmed cases, the medicines were delivered through UN interagency convoy.
