

Highlights:

- ❖ (2) AFP cases were reported during this week, the two cases are from Deir-ez-Zor
- ❖ (33) Suspected Measles cases were reported during this week: from Deir-ez-Zor (12), Ar-Raqqa (7), and Damascus (5).

Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting


The overall completeness of reporting was 48% due to the holiday of Eid Al-fiter, (542 out of total 1132 EWARS sentinel sites), (14) Governorates have reported this week; Timeliness of reporting was 82%.



The Morbidity Cases


- Out of the 64,694 total consultations, a total of 8, 829 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 2,877 cases were Influenza like Illness (32,59%), 4,753 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (53,83%), 207 cases of AJS, 89 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 33 cases of Suspected Measles, 66 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, 31 cases of Suspected Meningitis, and 2 cases of Acute Flaccid Paralysis.
- Graphs 1 and 2 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 year age groups respectively.


- ❖ AD constitutes (57.48%) among < 5 and (51%) among ≥ 5, while ILI constitutes (30.75%) of the cases among <5 and (34%) among ≥ 5.
- ❖ 53,5% of the cases were distributed among males, 58.6% of the cases were distributed among≥5 age group. In total 771 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 95 cases of Leishmaniasis (most of which were reported from Idleb 54%, 94 cases of Typhoid (most of which were reported from Deir-Ez-Zor 73%, and Rural Damascus 13%),44 cases of Brucellosis, 18 cases of Mumps, and 29 cases of Pertussis.

Graph 3 shows the trend analysis of suspected Measles cases reported between week 1 and week 26 of 2016 and 2017. It shows a decrease in reported SM cases.




Graph 4: shows the distribution of Suspected Measles cases per governorates reported during week 26 of 2017.

The Response

cVDPV2 response: The planned response of the two immunization rounds are planned for early July and August targeting children <5 years in Deir-ez-Zor governorate and in the southern part of Al-Shadadi district in Al-Hasakeh governorate. The first round vaccination of mOPV2 will target 328,000 children in Deir-ez-Zor, and 22,000 in Al-Shadadi.

There are 5 vaccine distribution centers with adequate cold chain in Bokamal, Hajien, Husienieh, Mayadeen, and Sor. These centers will distribute vaccine to all supervisors and collect empty vials on a daily basis. The micro plan includes a total of 355 vaccination teams and 61 supervisors are on standby for this activity. Campaign strategy is house to house in the affected villages and fixed posts in other areas.
