


# **Highlights:**

- ❖ 117 suspected Measles reported mainly from three governorates, Deir ezzor, Hassaka, and Raqqa.
- Improve the coverage of EWARS in Deir Ezzor by recruiting 20 sentinel sites in the EWARS.

# **Completeness & Timeliness of Reporting**

- ❖ The overall completeness of reporting was 81%; (1048 out of total 1299 EWARS sentinel sites). 14 governorates have reported this week.
- ❖ Timeliness of reporting was 87%.




### The Morbidity Cases


❖ Out of the 247,387 total consultations, a total of 26,216 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 11,211 cases were Influenza like Illness (43%), 9,220 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (35%), 622 cases of AJS, 205 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 117 cases of Suspected Measles, 94 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, and 34 cases of Suspected Meningitis.

**❖ Graphs 2 and 3 below** show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 year age groups respectively.




- **♦** 50% of the cases were distributed among males. 59% of the cases were distributed among ≥5 age group.
- ❖ AD constitutes (40%) among < 5 and (32%) among ≥ 5, while ILI constitutes (42%) of the cases among <5 and (43%) among ≥ 5
- ❖ In total 4,710 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 762 cases of Leishmaniasis (mostly from Aleppo, Idlib and Deit Ezzor), 341 cases of Brucellosis, 434 cases of Typhoid, 4 cases of TB, 102 Pertussis, and Mumps 27
- ❖ **Graph 4:** shows the trend analysis of suspected Measles cases reported between week 1 and week 27of 2017 and 2018. It shows a slight decrease in suspected cases in week 27.



**Graph 5:** Trend analysis of suspected Typhoid cases in Alhole camp. The graph indicates that slight decline in reported cases.



**Graph 6** shows the trend analysis of top four diseases to total consultations. It shows an increase in the trend of Acute Diarrhea cases in this week, this increase is synchronized with summer season.

❖ The table below shows comparison between reported cases in week-26 and week-27 2018. The table shows increase in most reported cases, this increase is attributed to increase of reporting sites in Deir Ezzor.

# **❖** The Response

#### Measles:

The National measles campaign started on 15 July 2018 for a period of two weeks in targeted governorates: Rural Damascus, Aleppo, Homs, Hama, Al-Hasakah, Ar-Raqqa. Rural Deir-ez-Zor is postponed to next week, as approvals are still in process; the preliminary results are as follows: 196,897 children were vaccinated in the first two days (16% from the total target).

- 10,122 children were vaccinated in Rural Damascus four districts (Darayya, Douma, Harasta and Nashrabiye) and 5 IDP shelters.
- 41,904 children were vaccinated in Ar-Raqqa governorate covering (Raqqa city, Tal Abyad, Al –Tabqa, Karameh, Madan, Debsi Afnan) in addition to 8,782 children in Ain al Arab district.
- 8387 children were vaccinated during the first 3 days in Homs and the target for mobile teams in northern rural Homs is high, as they are providing all kind of vaccines including measles for dropout children.
- 50,000 children were vaccinated in Al-Hasakah.

### **Surveillance system in Deir Ezzor:**

WHO is working to strengthen the surveillance system in Deir Ezzor, by recruiting more sentinel sites in EWARS surveillance system, and training health care providers including pharmacists and nurses on standard cases definitions of priority communicable diseases. During this week 20 sentinel sites were recruited to report for the EWARS, total number of EWARS sites in Deir Ezzor reached to 154, the completeness of reporting is 70%.
