Highlights:


- Four AFP cases were detected in Lattakia (1), Aleppo (1), Damascus (1) and Homs (1).
- ❖ A measles outbreak has been reported beginning of 2017 due to disruption of childhood immunization program.

Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting

- ❖ The overall completeness of reporting was 79%; (877out of total 1112 EWARS sentinel sites).
 (13) Governorates have reported this week. Raqqa did not report this week due to the restrictions imposed by ISIS.
- ❖ Timeliness of reporting is 57%.

The Morbidity Cases

- Out of the 198,074 total consultations, a total of 24,797 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 15,802 cases were Influenza like Illness (62%), 5,144 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (22%), 542 cases of AJS, 203 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 43 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, 58 cases of Suspected Measles, 6 cases of Suspected Meningitis, and 4 case of Acute Flaccid Paralysis.
- Graphs 1 and 2 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and ≥ 5 year age groups respectively.



- ❖ AD constitutes (23.05%) among < 5 and (19.02%) among ≥ 5, while ILI constitutes (65.32%) of the cases among <5 and (62.31) among ≥ 5.
- ❖ 50% of the cases were distributed among males.59% of the cases were distributed among≥5 age group.
- ❖ In total 2,995 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 674 cases of Leishmaniasis (most of which were reported from Idleb 45%, Hamah 28%, and Aleppo 12%), 277 cases of Typhoid (most of which were reported from Idleb 59%, DierEzor 25%, and Hama 5%), 109 cases of Brucellosis, 30 cases of Pertussis, and 18 cases of TB.

Graph 3 shows the trend analysis of Acute Sever Respiratory Infections cases reported between week 43 of 2016 and week 8 of 2017. It shows a decrease in the number of reported SARI cases, this decrease is synchronized with seasonal changes.




Table 2 shows a comparison between reported cases in week 6 & week 7. It shows no significant increase in the reported cases through the EWARS.

❖ The Response

Acute flaccid paralysis: Stool samples were collected from AFP cases and sent to the reference lab in Damascus. Laboratory test for AFP cases detected in week 6 showed negative results for Polio. The next round of Polio national immunization campaign will be conducted between 12 & 16 of March 2017

Severe Acute Respiratory Infections: During the period from week (47) 2016 till week (8) 2017, total number of (95) samples were collected from SARI cases admitted to ICU and sent to the reference laboratory in Damascus, the results showed negative for H1N1 for all the cases.

Measles: (20) laboratory confirmed cases out of (44) samples were reported in January 2017, comparing with the same period in 2016 number of suspected measles cases was (28) cases and zero positive Measles cases. Cases in 2017 were reported mostly from the governorates of Quniatera (8), Damascus (7), and Rural Damascus (4). As a response measure to positive Measles cases; Ministry of Health is planning to conduct vaccination activities in the affected areas
