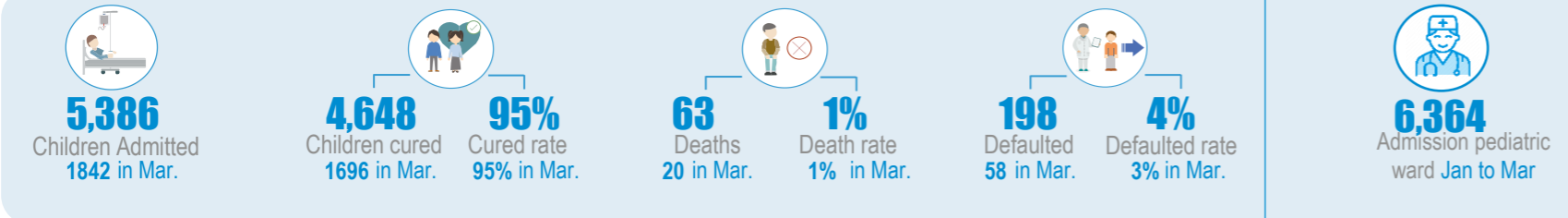


Key Figures - From January to March 2022

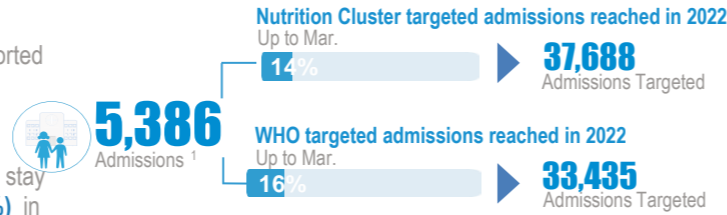


Service Utilization January-March

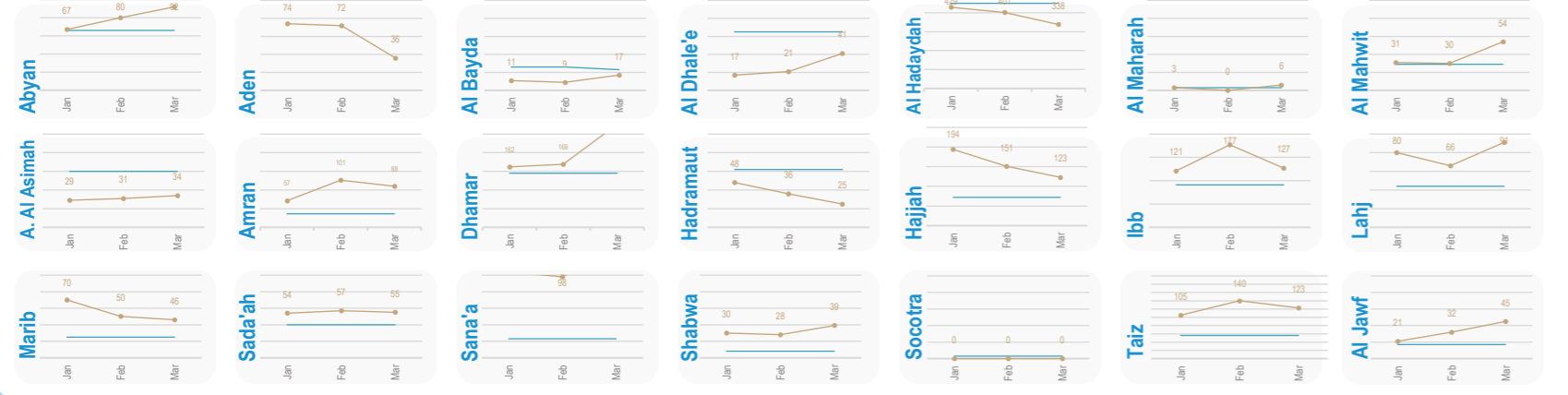
From January to March **5,386** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **1,243 (23%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**95%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**5,386**) in total benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**2%**) in October.

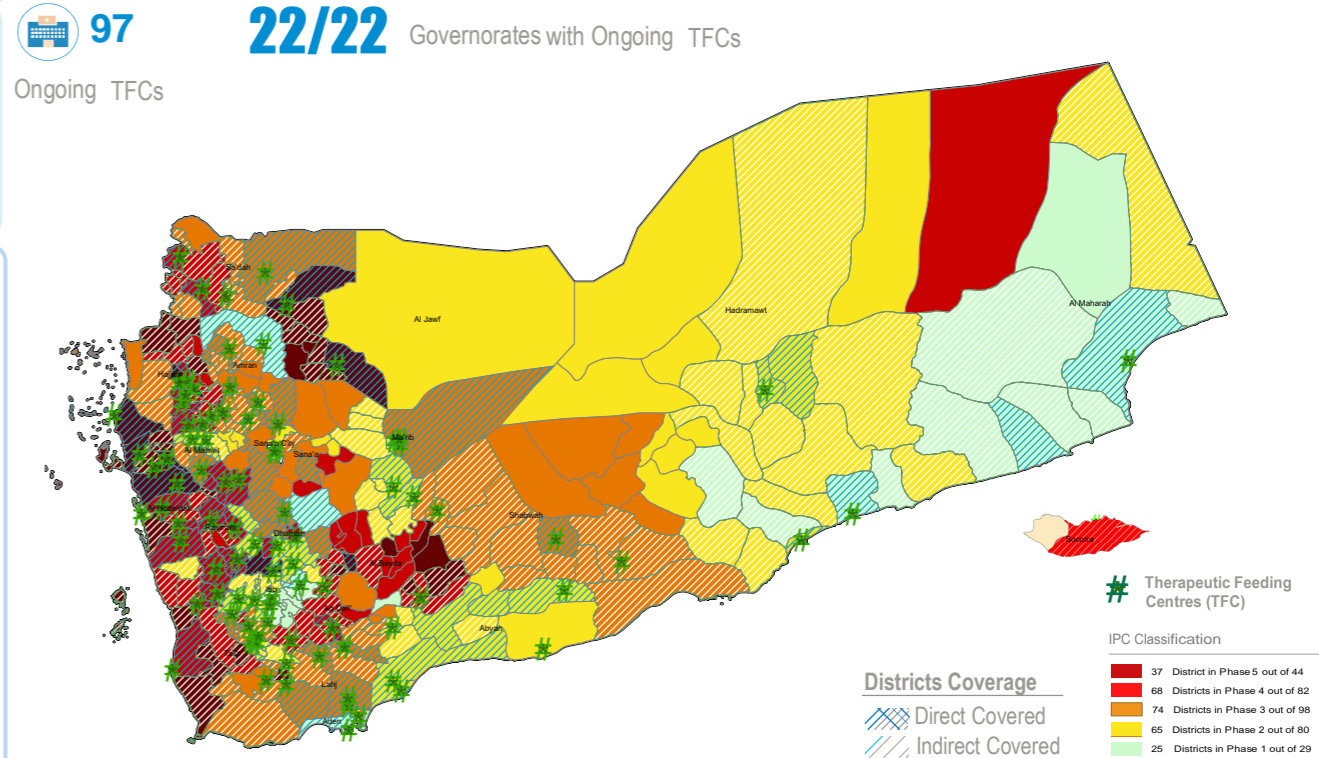
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **6,364** children were admitted in From January to March in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



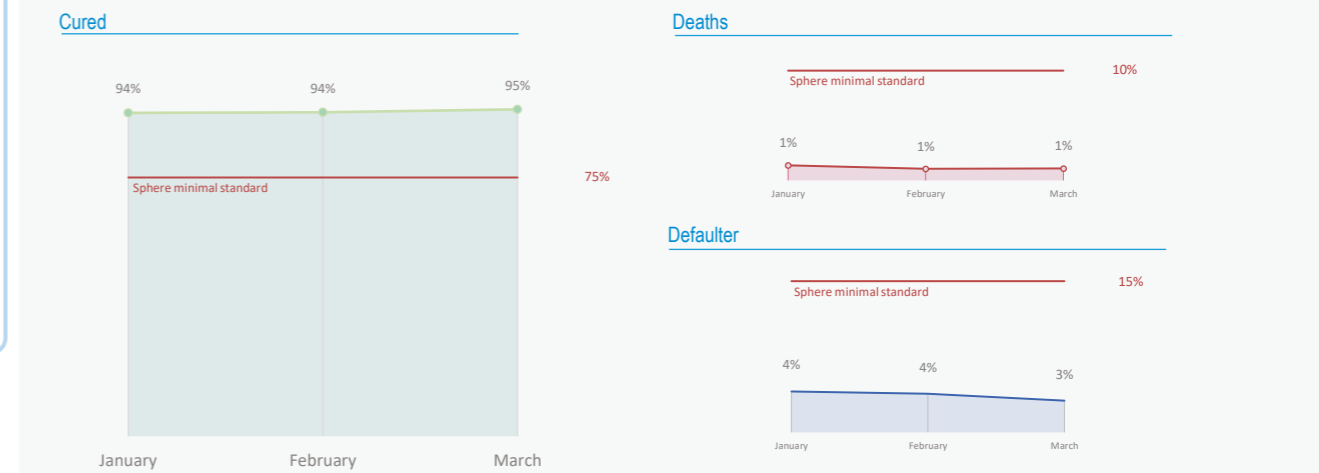
Service Utilization per Governorate



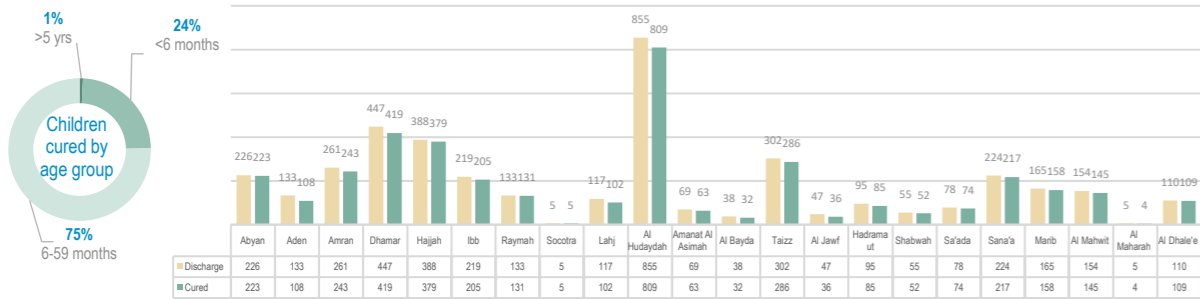
TFC Coverage by district (with IPC Classification)



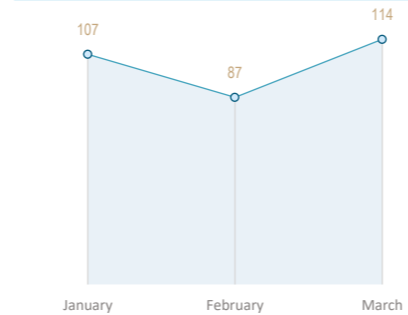
TFCs Performance Indicators January-March



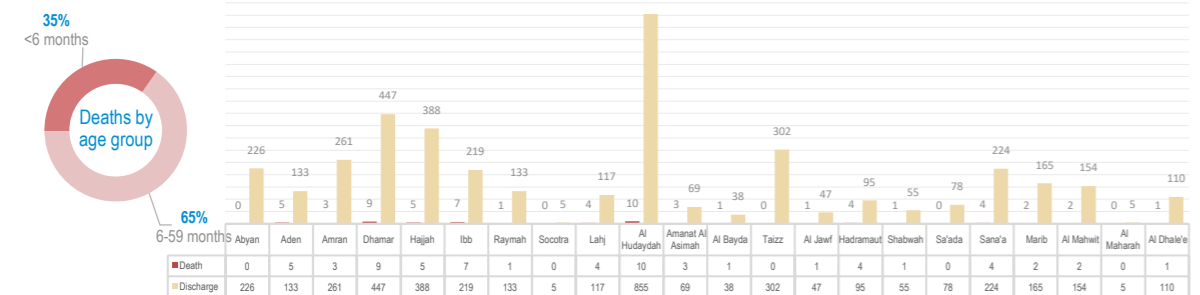
Cured Children per Governorate in March



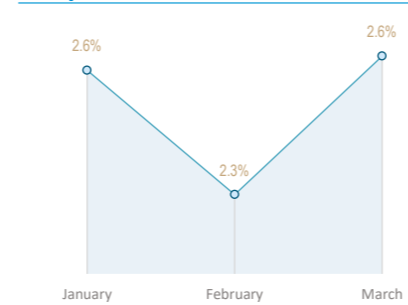
Oedema
