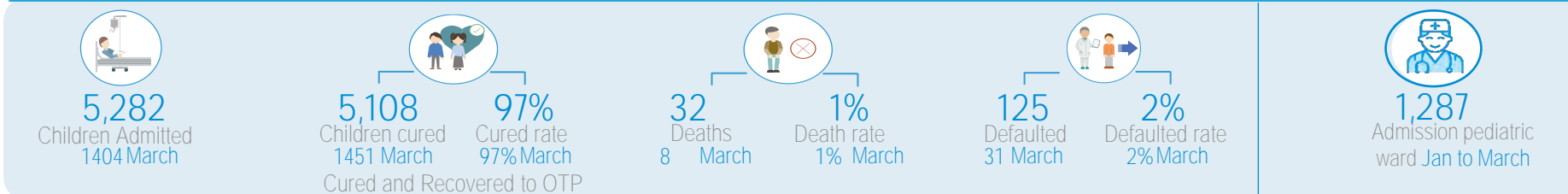


## Key Figures - From January to March

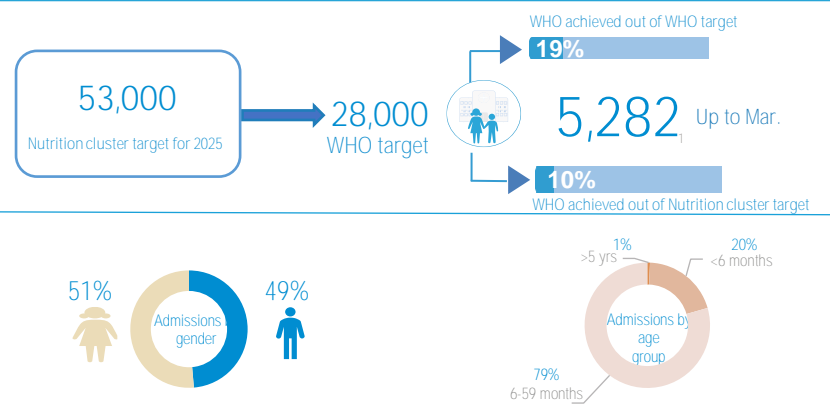


## Service Utilization January-March

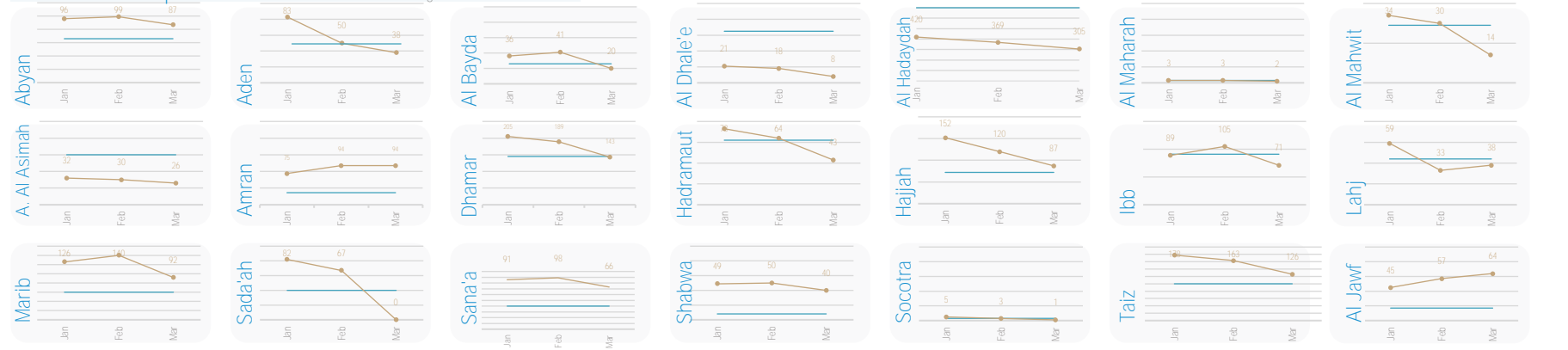
From January to March **5,282** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **1,049 (20%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**97%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**5,282**) in total, benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**2%**) in March.

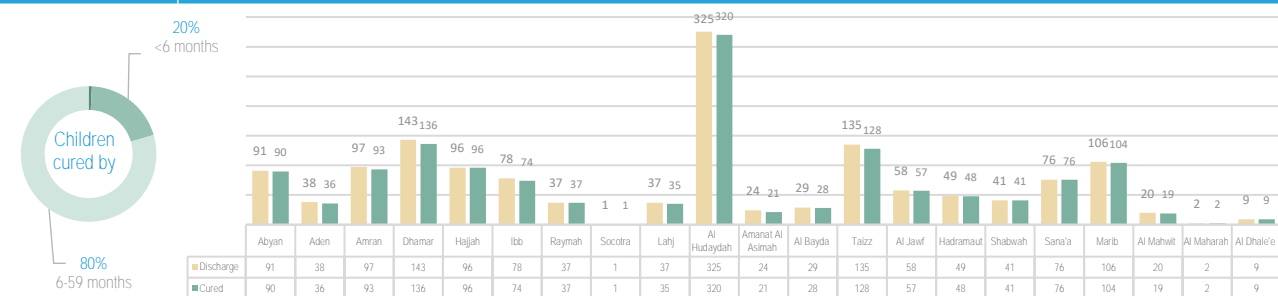
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **1,287** children were admitted from Jan to March in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



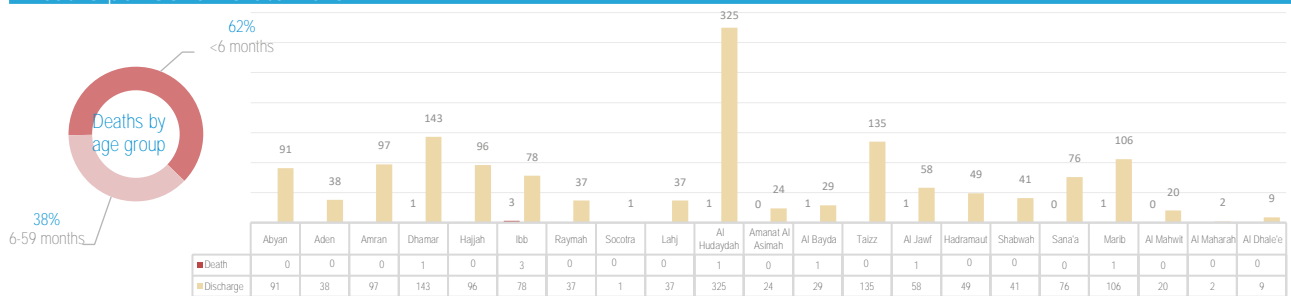
## Service Utilization per Governorate



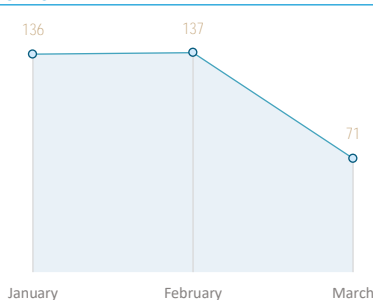
## Cured Children per Governorate March



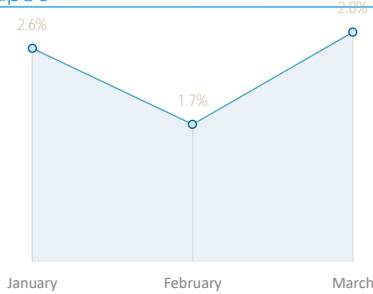
## Deaths per Governorate March



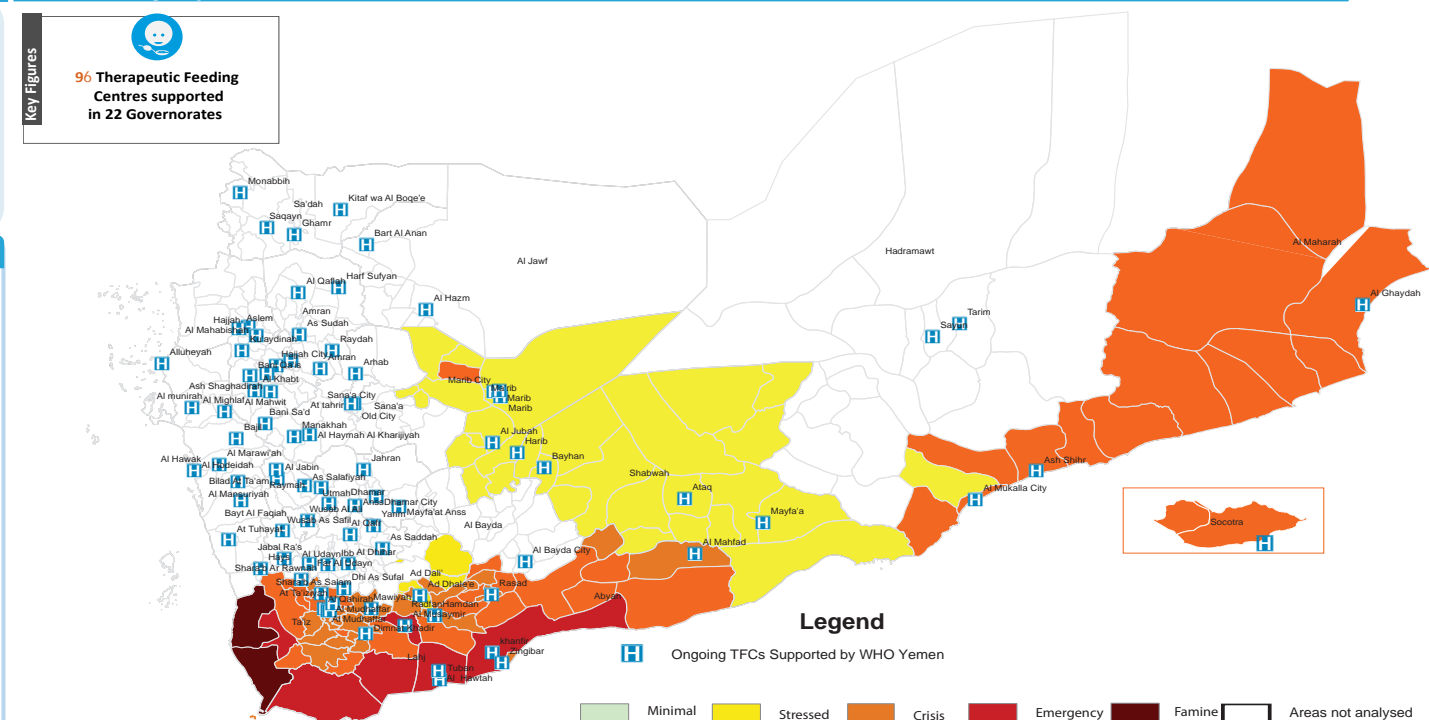

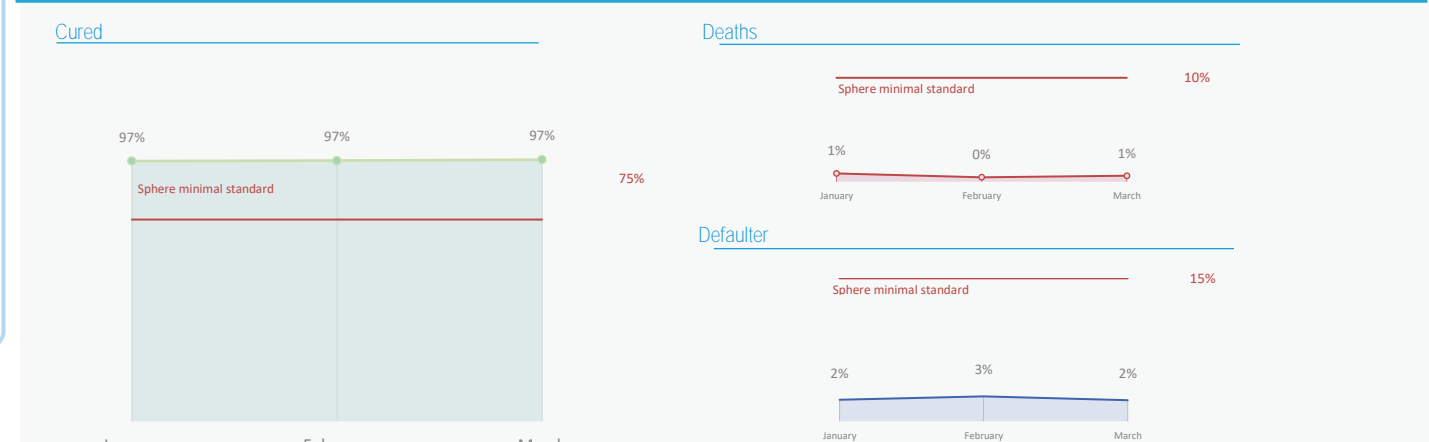
