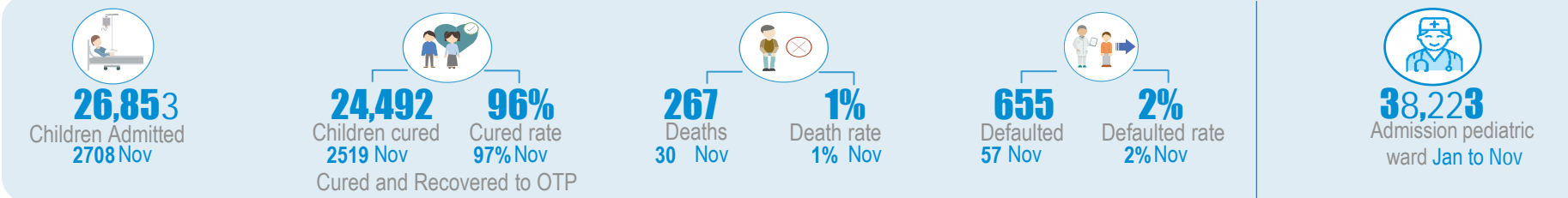

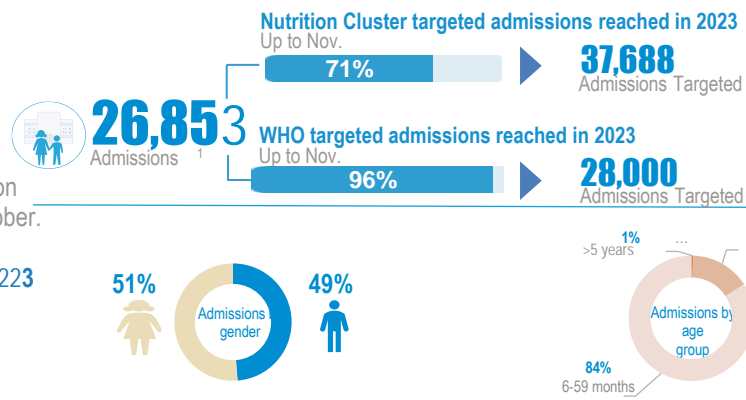


### Service Utilization January-November

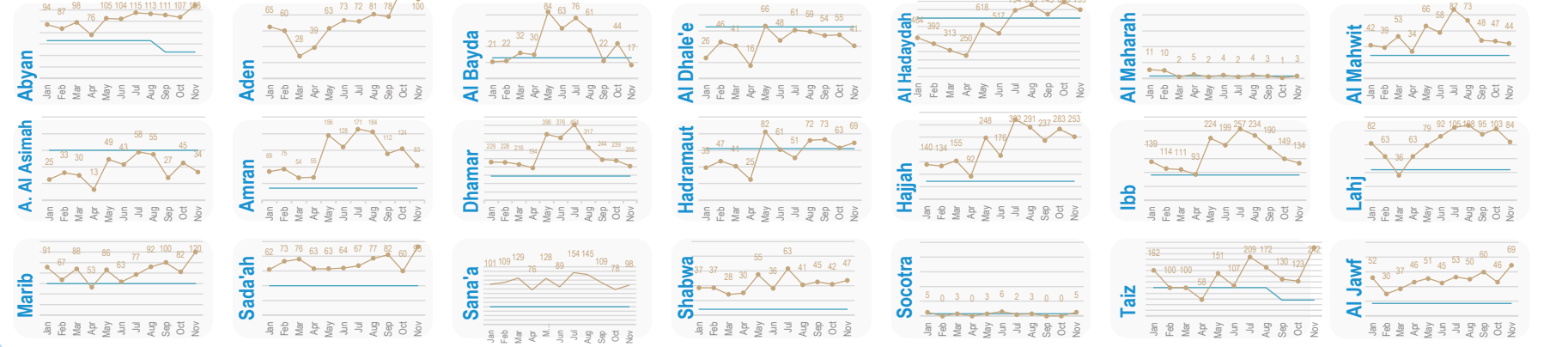
From January to Nov **26,853** children have received life-saving services in WHO-supported TFCs, of which **4,139 (15%)** are children under 6 months.

The quality of service is evidenced by the recovery (**96%**) and death (**1%**) rates. Each caregiver (**26,853**) in total, benefits from at least 5 counselling sessions per hospital stay on IYCF best practices. This might contribute to the observed decrease in relapse rate (**1.2%**) in October.

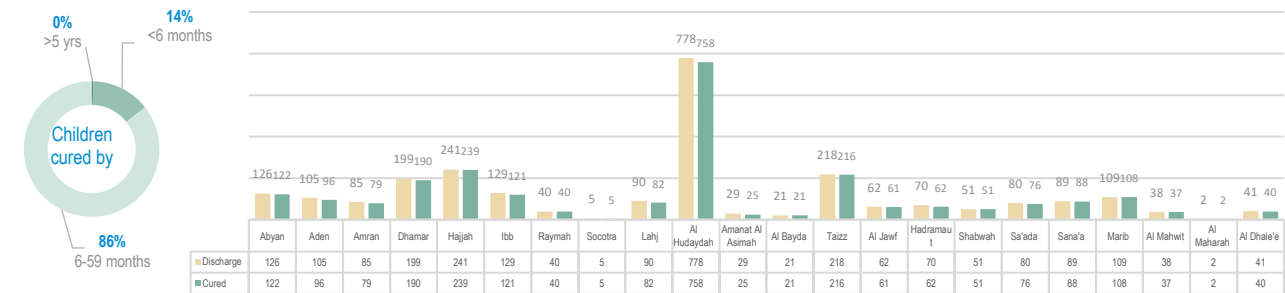
By ensuring the care for most critical cases in pediatric wards in referral hospitals with TFCs, **38,223** children were admitted from Jan to Nov in these referral hospitals for intensive care.



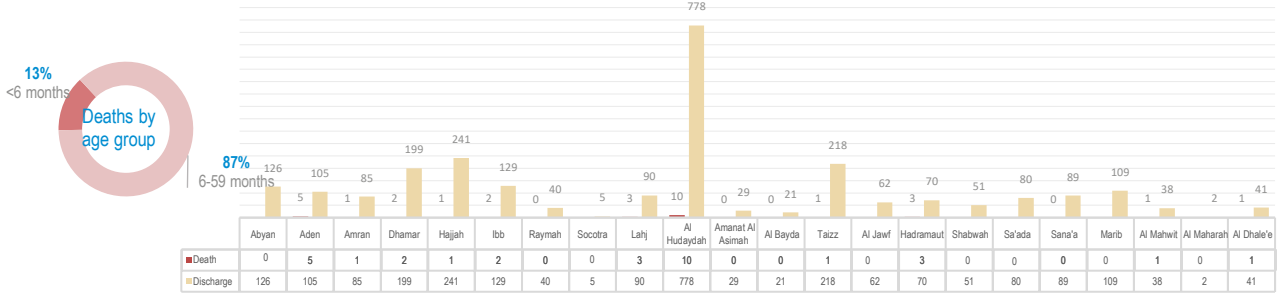
### Service Utilization per Governorate



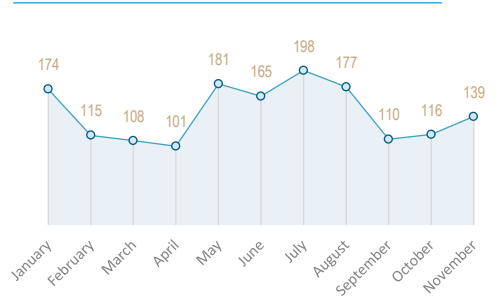
### Cured Children per Governorate November



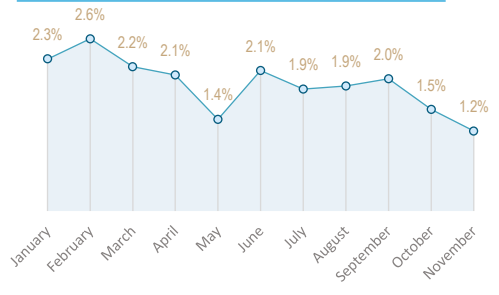
### Deaths per Governorate November



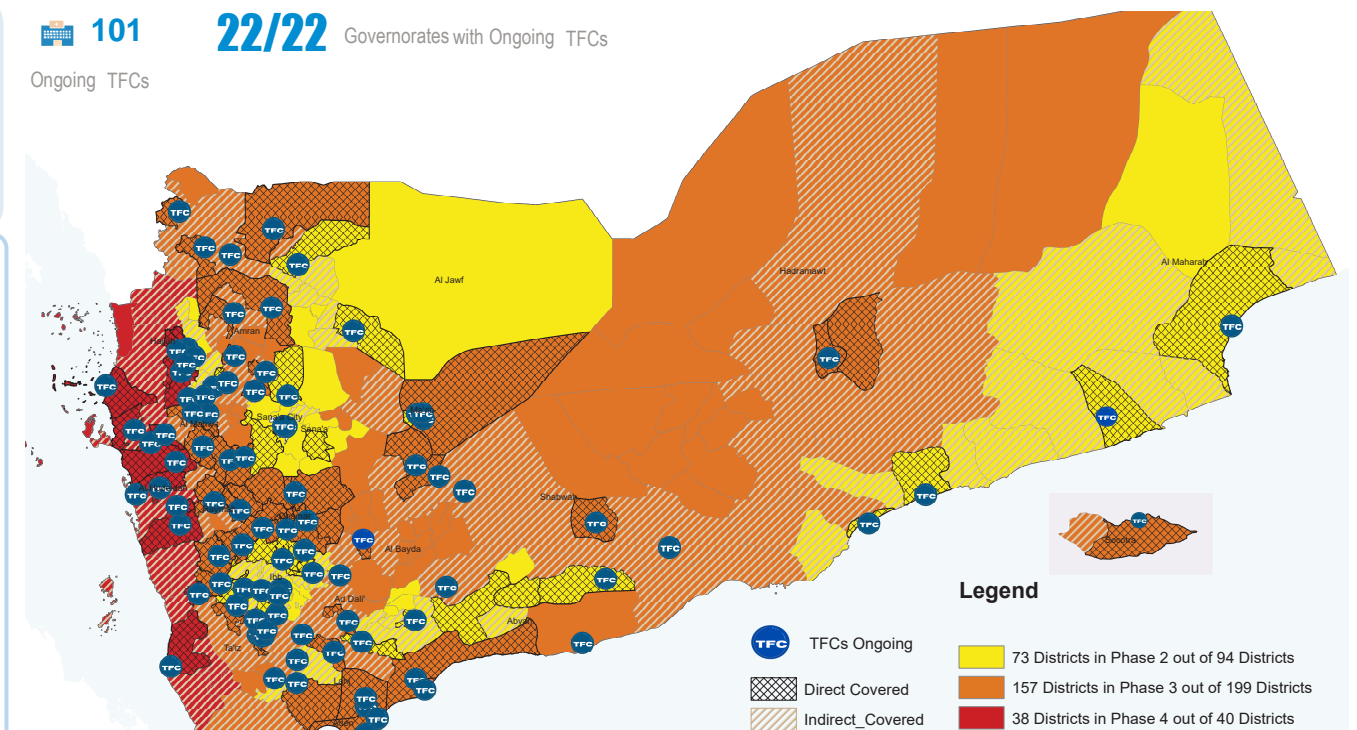

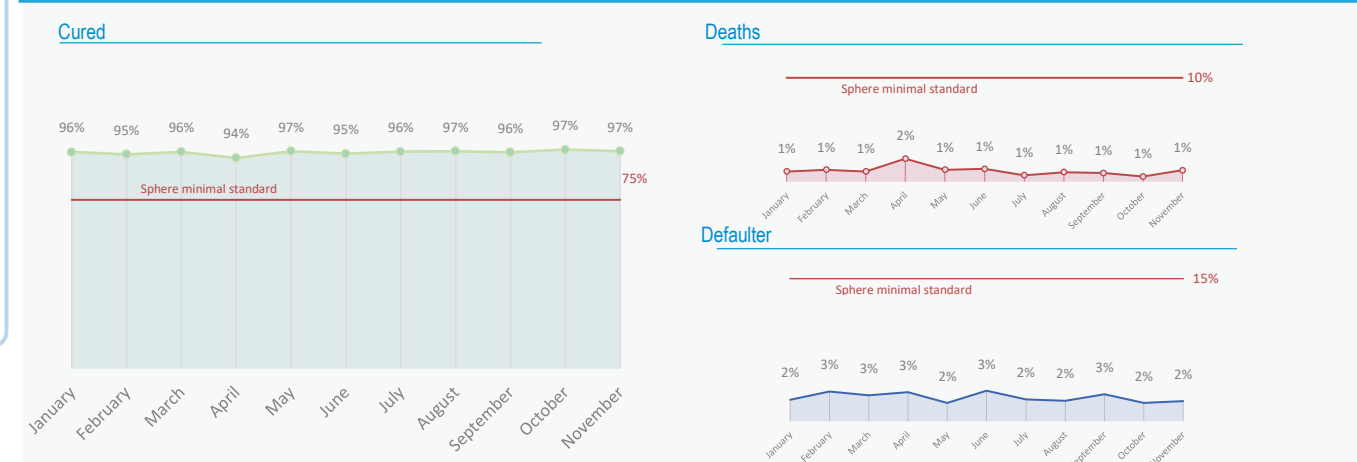
