

Key updates, November 2017

- Conflict continued to displace families and individuals, which created pressure on health services around the country in November 2017. Due to the newly increased number of internally displaced persons from Khogiani district in the Eastern region, the host communities of the surrounding areas were stretched with patients.
- Number of closed health facilities was increased in the southern region due to the deteriorated security situation.
- In the eastern region, emergency health services were provided to a total of 6432 IDPs by partners (AADA, PU-AMI) in November.
- In addition, 25 020 returnees and IDPs received outpatient services.
- WHO maintained emergency health services at zero point Torkham through a health centre administered by WHO, UNFPA and AADA, as well as via fixed health facilities in the region.
- A total of 164 families (739 individuals) of documented returnees returned to Afghanistan through Spin Boldak gate from Pakistan.
- A total of 281 patients were treated by UNHCR encashment center health facility with medicines provided by WHO.
