



April 2020 - European Union Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid has furthered its generous funding to WHO Afghanistan with an additional €2.8 million to the WHO Health Emergencies Programme to support the country's fight against COVID-19.

The European Union Humanitarian Aid has been a long-term partner to WHO Afghanistan and in January 2019, it pledged €4.5 million for a period of 2 years. The current funding comes in parallel with a pledge of €30 million in humanitarian aid to combat COVID-19 in Asia and Africa, from which Afghanistan will receive €2.5 million of the funding. This will amount to €5.3 million in EU humanitarian aid funding to WHO in Afghanistan this year.
