



**DELTA VARIANT
WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW**

Symptoms caused by the Delta variant aren't different from symptoms caused by other COVID-19 variants. Common symptoms remain fever, dry cough and tiredness. Other symptoms include loss of smell and taste, diarrhoea, headache, sore throat, aches and pains, conjunctivitis and rashes.



Delta is twice as infectious as the original strain of COVID-19 and about 50% more infectious than other detected variants of concern.

New evidence shows that even if people have been infected with Delta, they can still be at increased risk of reinfection.

Most people infected by Delta are unvaccinated and have higher risk of developed severe symptoms that require hospitalization.

Delta infection among vaccinated people is rare, but if they are infected, they are unlikely to develop severe symptoms or need hospitalization.

Vaccines are effective against COVID-19 variants. People who have taken both doses have an extra layer of protection and are less likely to face severe illness or death.
