

Oman hosted the WHO Leadership for Health Programmes from 8 to 18 February 2015. This programme is an initiative of the WHO Regional Office for the Eastern Mediterranean. It aims to strengthen the capacity of public health in countries of the Region. This 4-week-long intensive programme offered, in collaboration with the Harvard School of Public Health, trained 25 current and future public health leaders.
