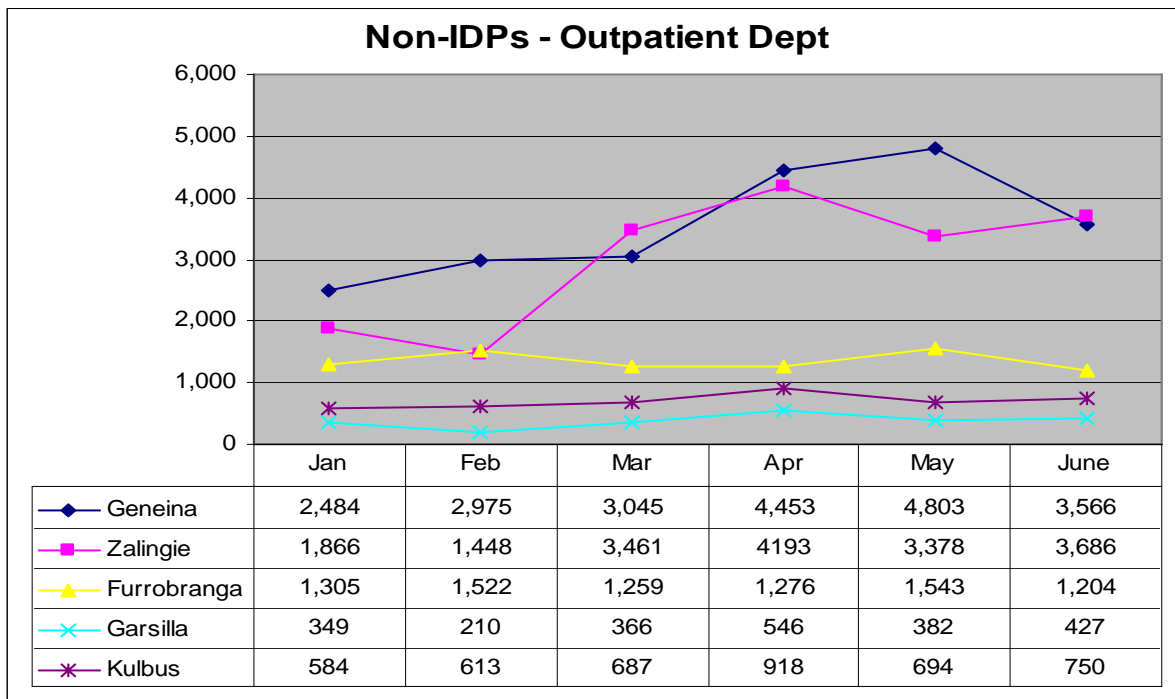
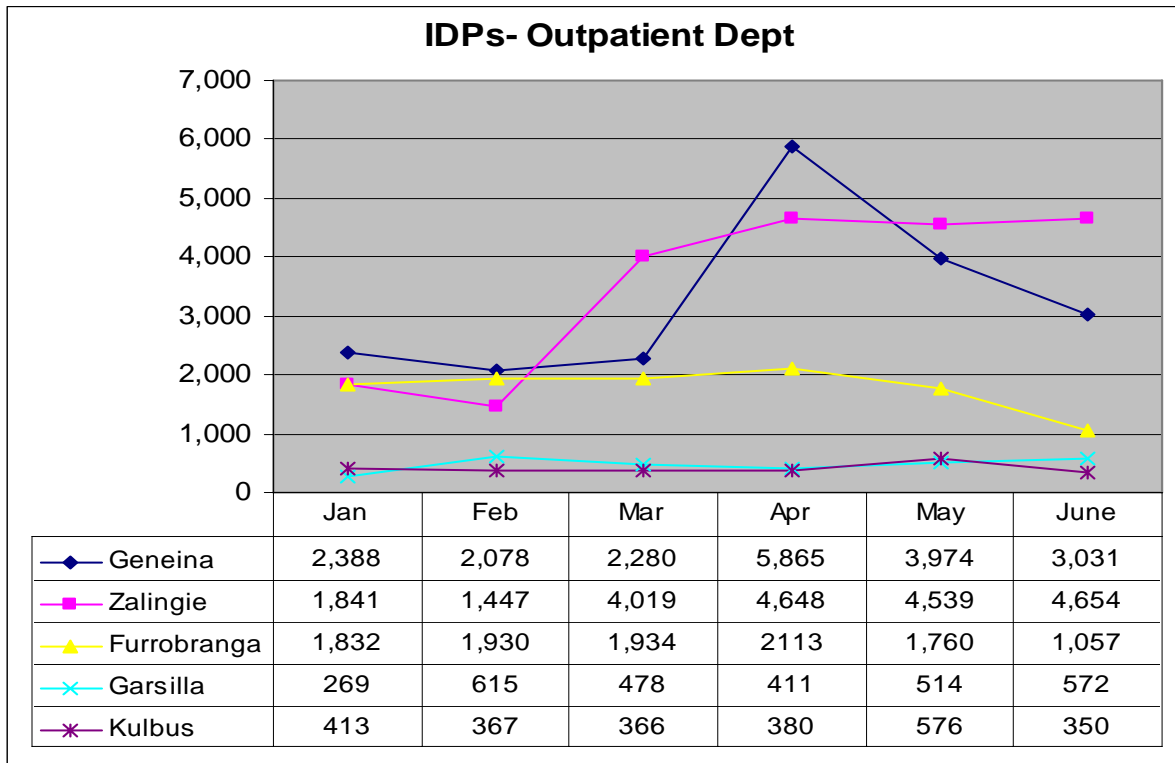

General Information

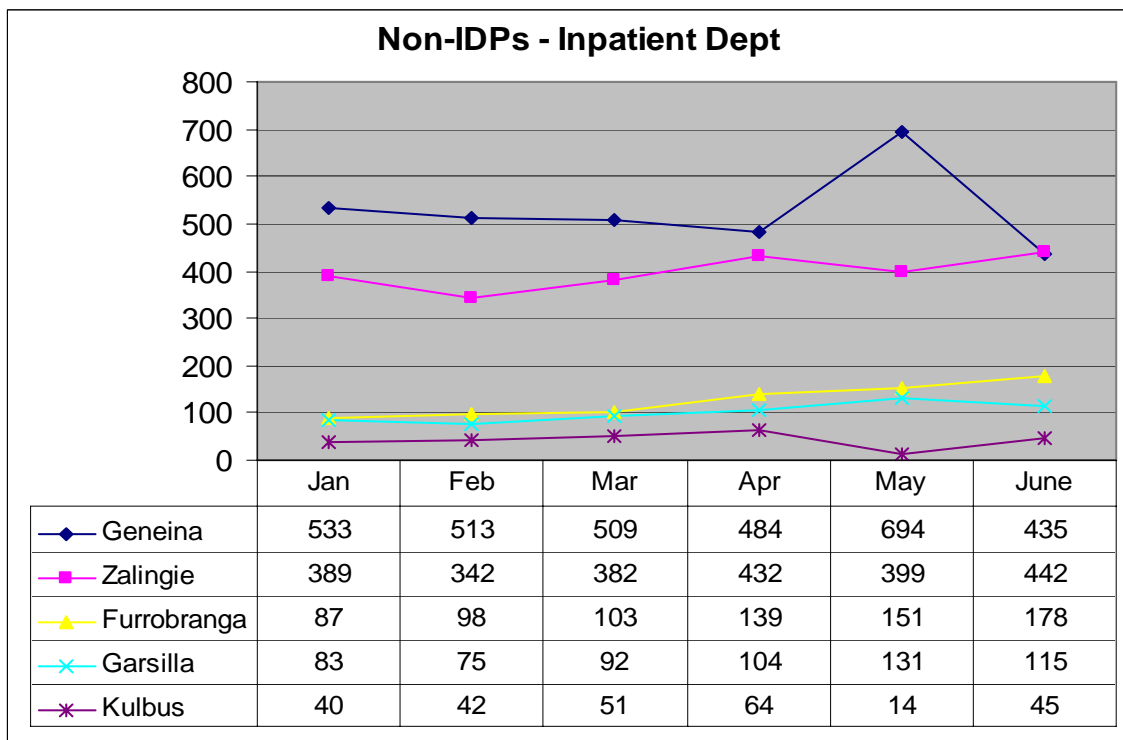
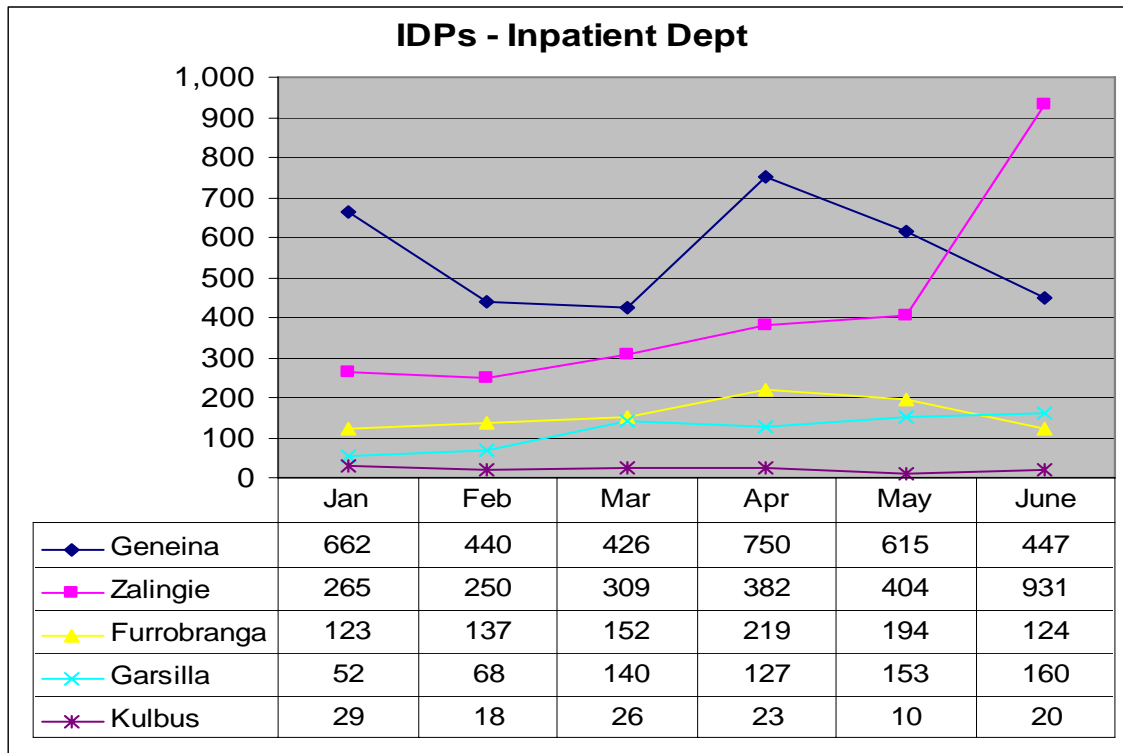
Outpatient Department:

- The number of **IDPs & Non-IDPs** in Zalingie hospital increased dramatically from Feb 07 to reach the peak on Apr 07.
- Apr 07 was the peak time for the IDPs in El-Geneina Hospital, while May was the peak time for Non-IDPs.
- The number of **IDPs** in Furrbaranga hospital was declining since Apr 07, while the number of **Non-IDPs** remains static.
- The number of **IDPs & Non-IDPs** in Garsilla , and Kulbus hospitals remains static.



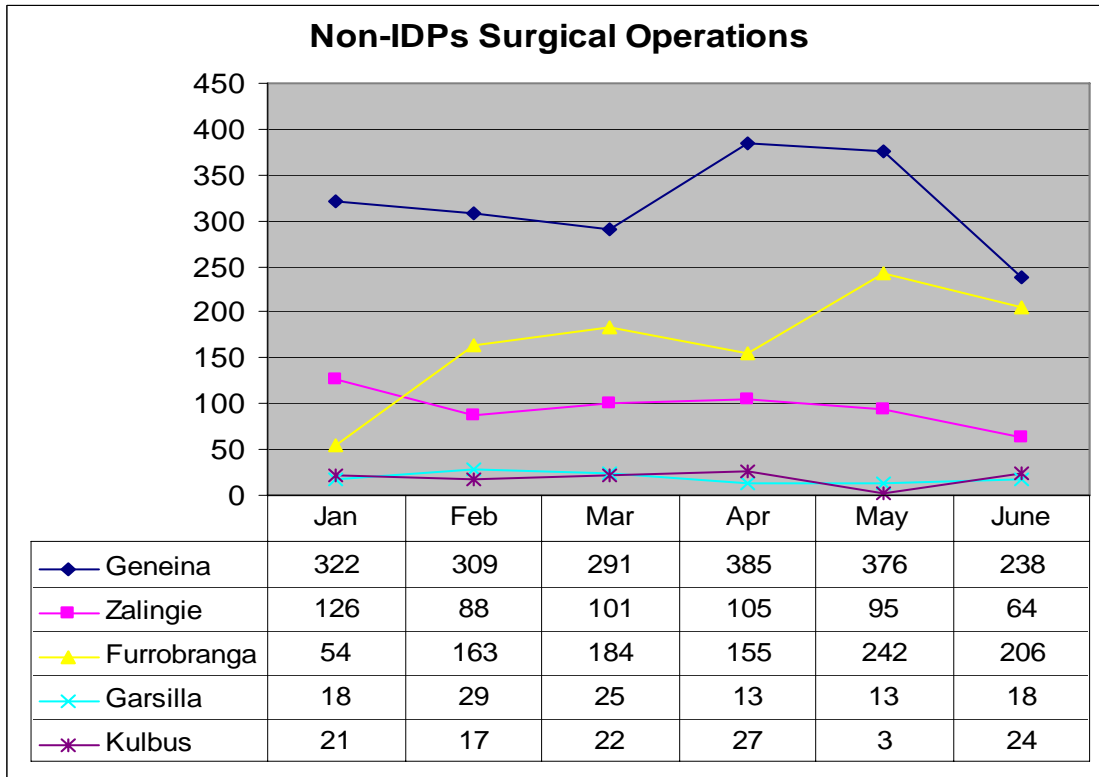
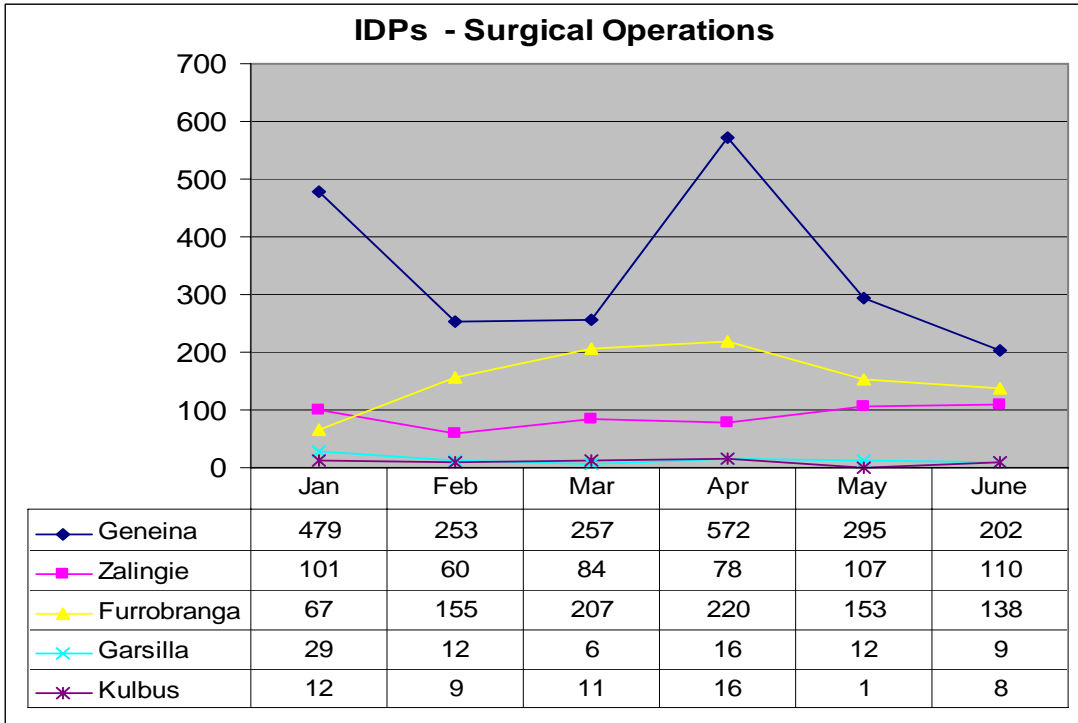
Inpatient Department:

- The number of **IDPs** in El-Geneina Hospital was fluctuating since Jan; the peak time was in Apr, while May 07 was the peak time for **non-IDPs**
- In Zalingie, the number of **IDPs** was slightly increasing since Jan up to May 07, to doubly increase during June 07



Surgical Operations:

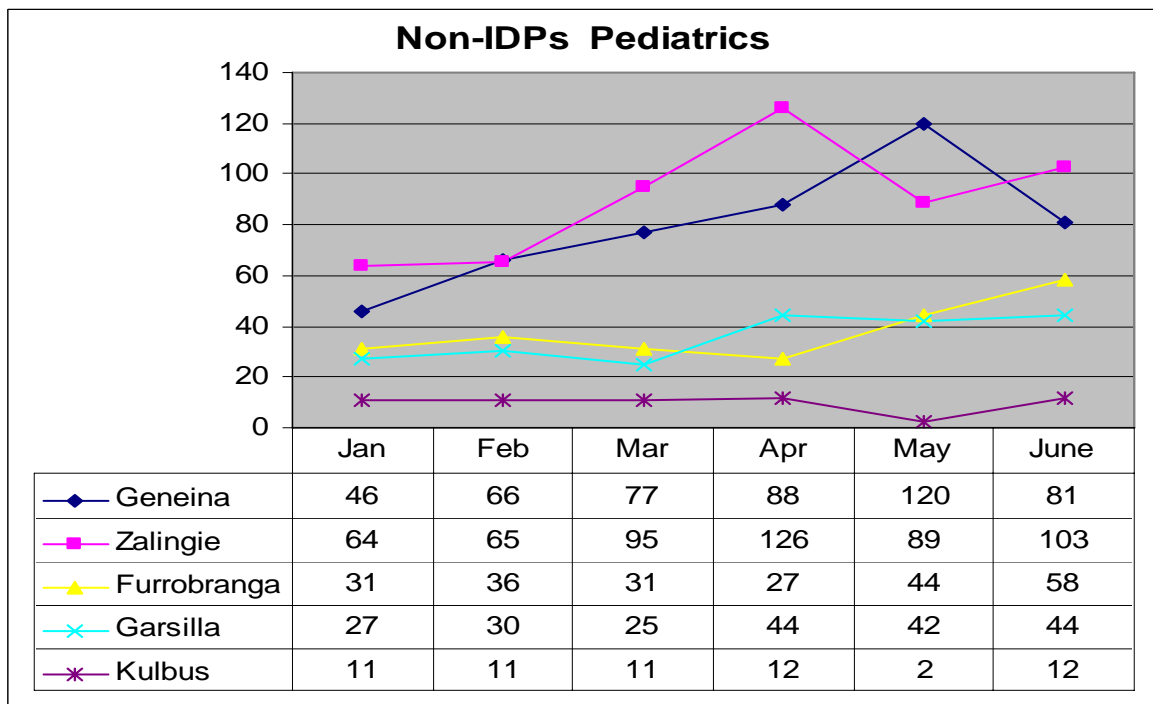
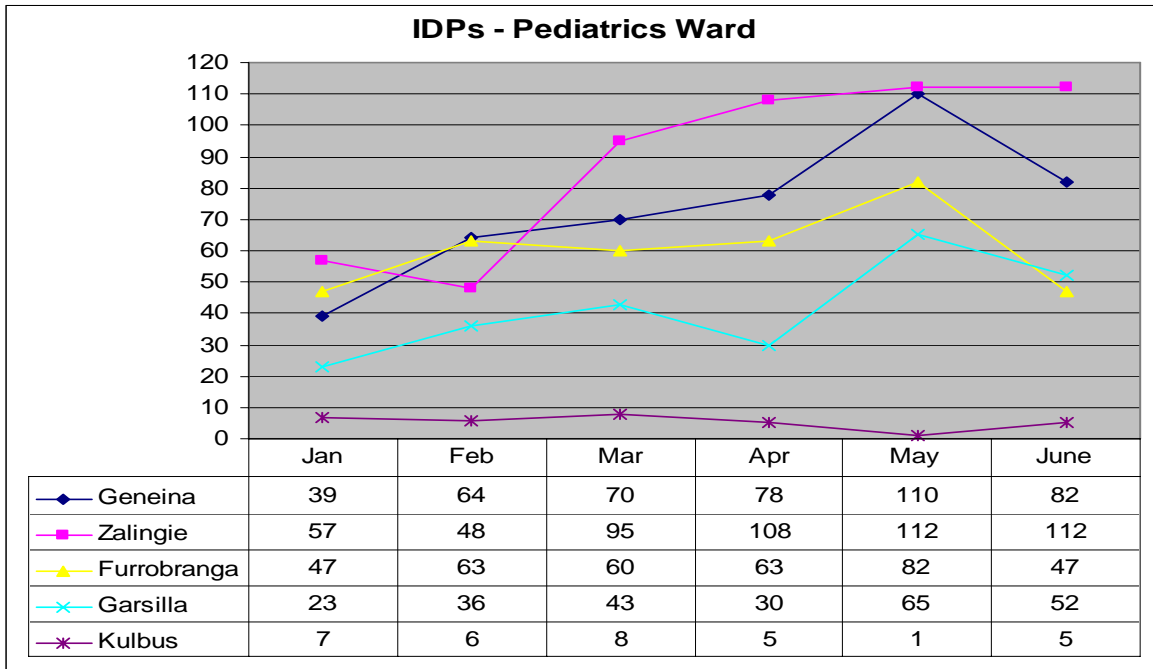
Generally, the highest number of operations was performed in El-Geneina hospital; Apr 07 was the peak time, while the least number of operations was in June 07.



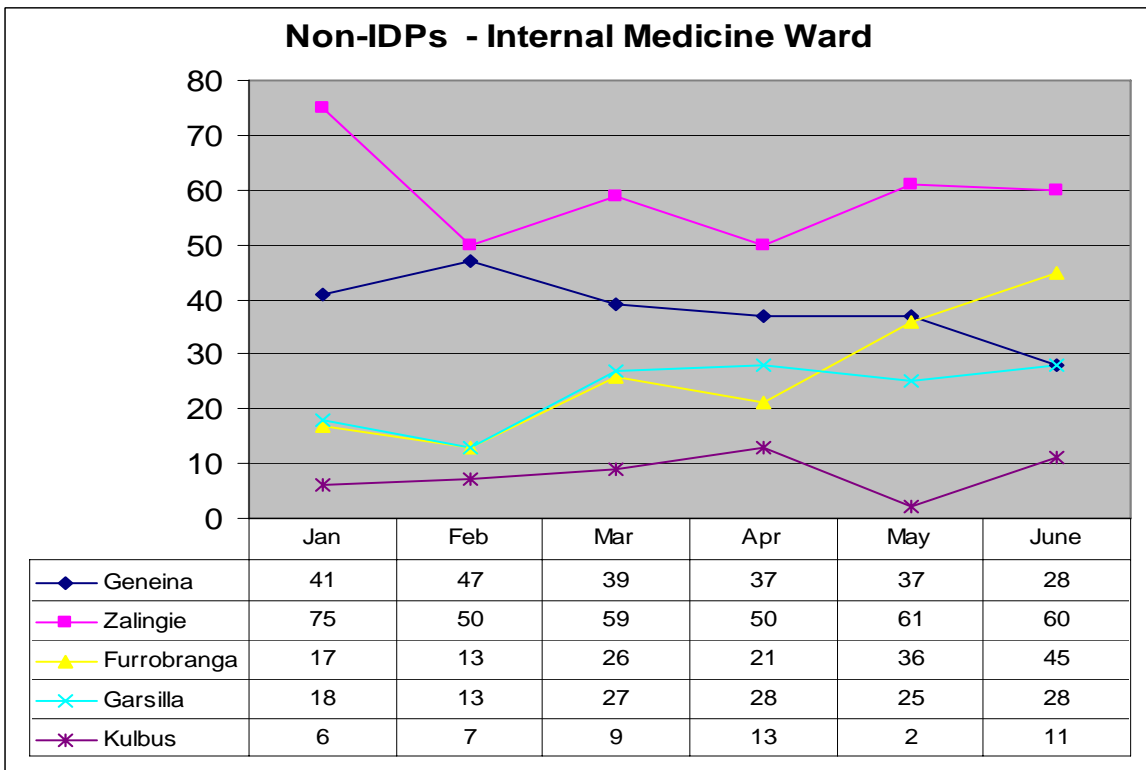
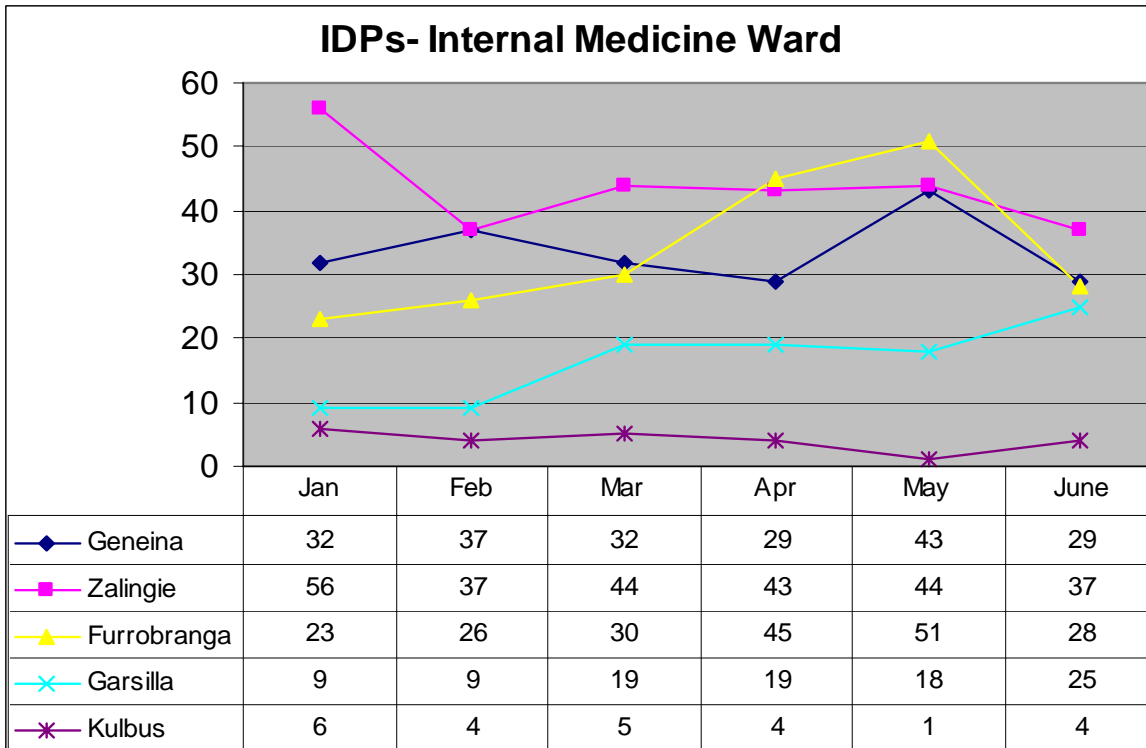
Wards Workload

Analysis of the wards workload has been conducted for **all hospitals** per **ward** (for IDPs and Non-IDPs), as shown in the linear graphs below.

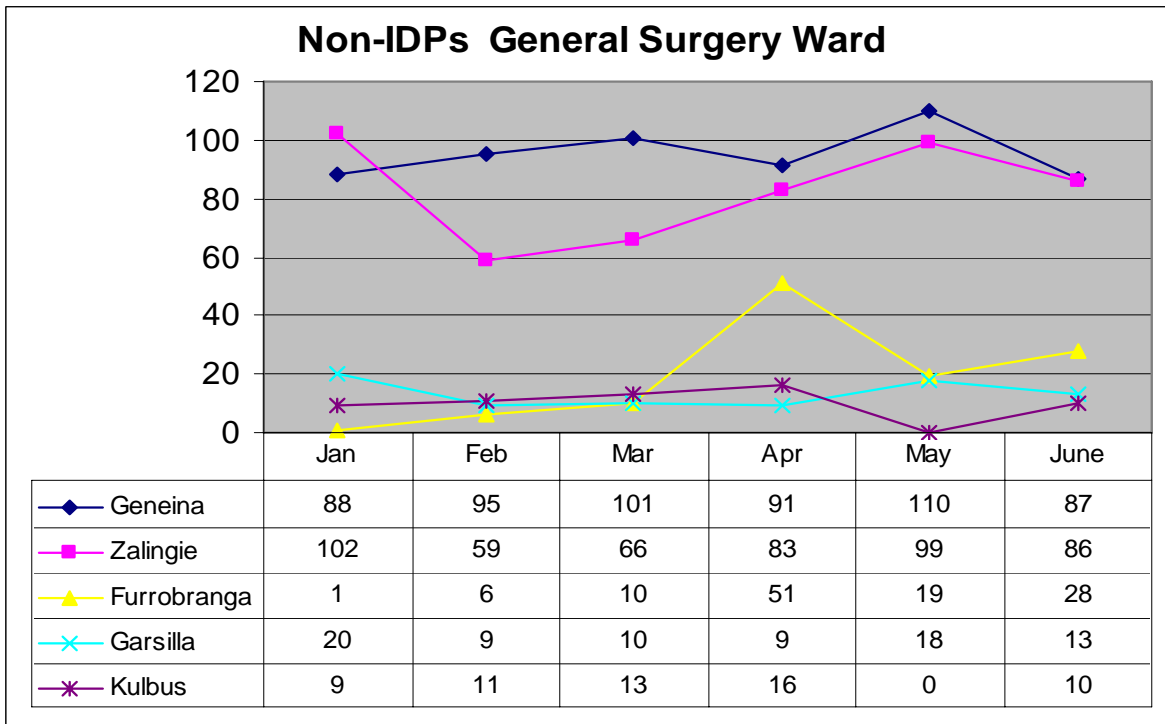
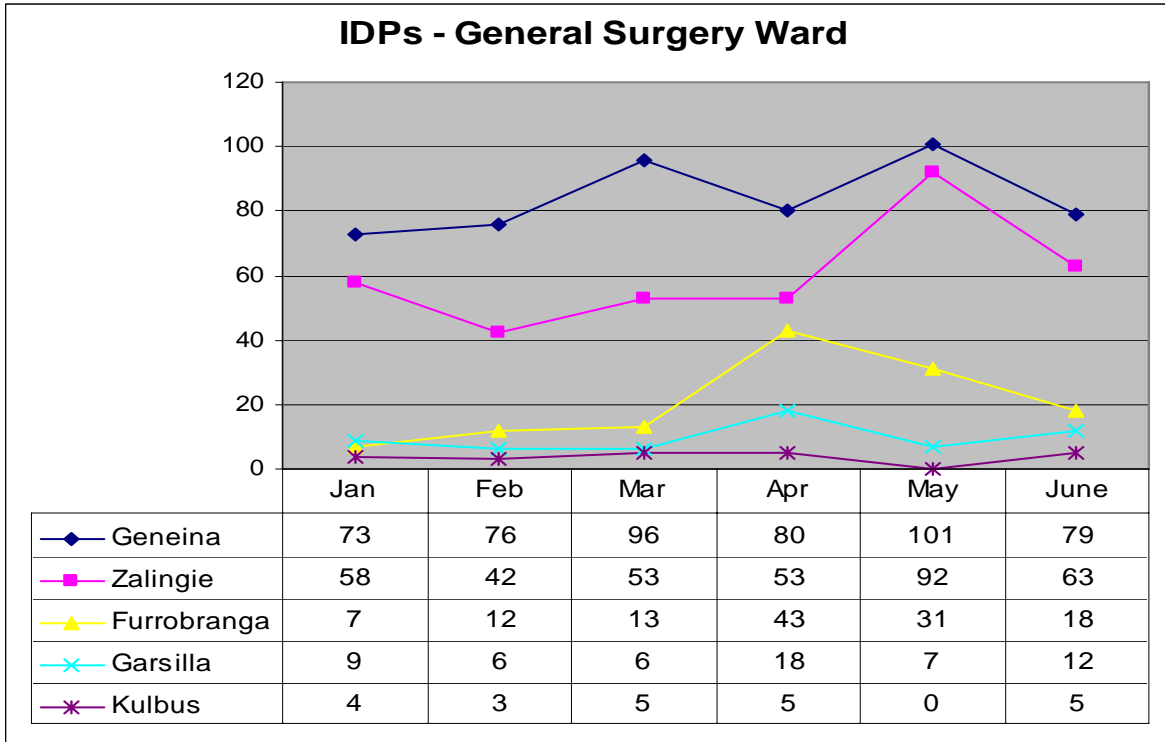
Pediatrics Ward



Internal Medicine Ward

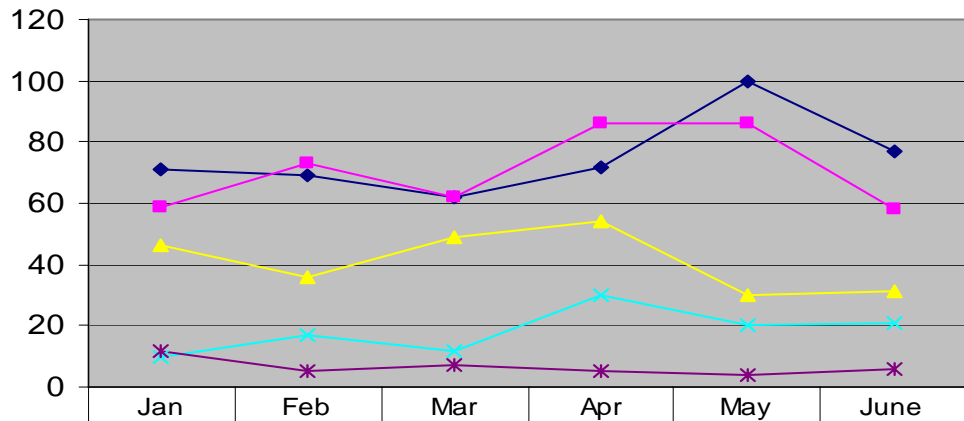


General Surgery Ward



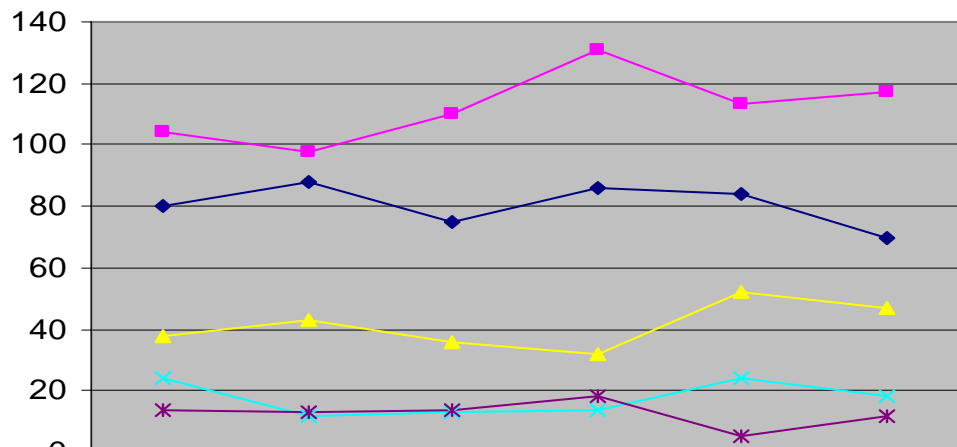
