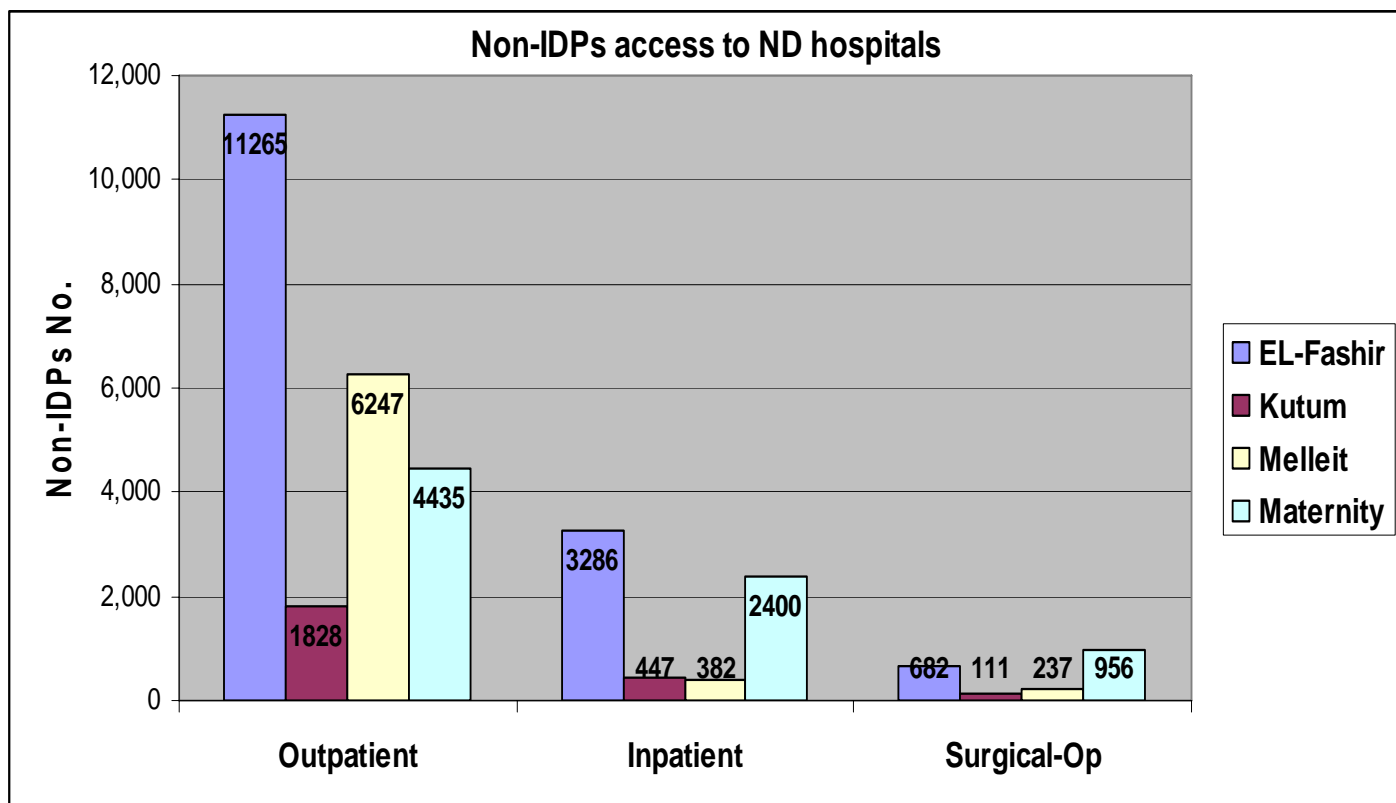
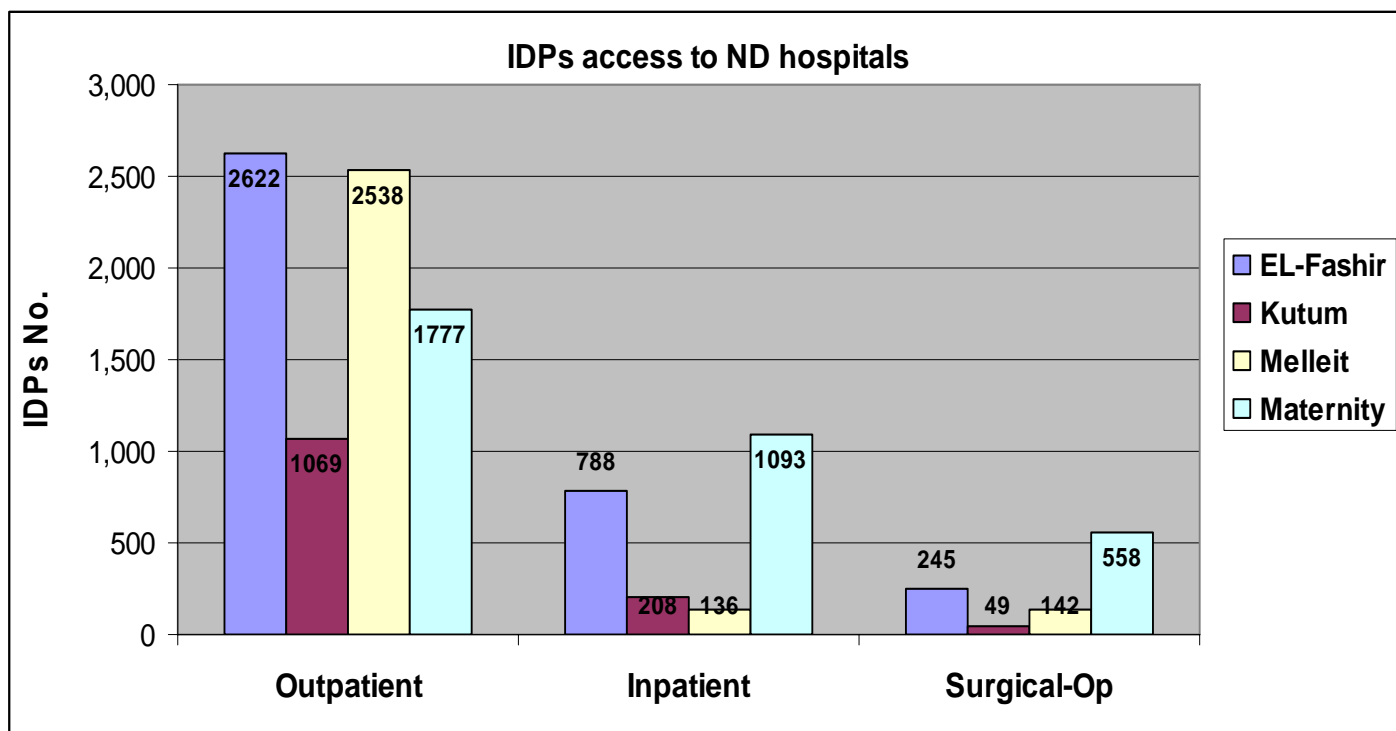
Analytical Report – 1st OCT 06 to 13th Mar 07

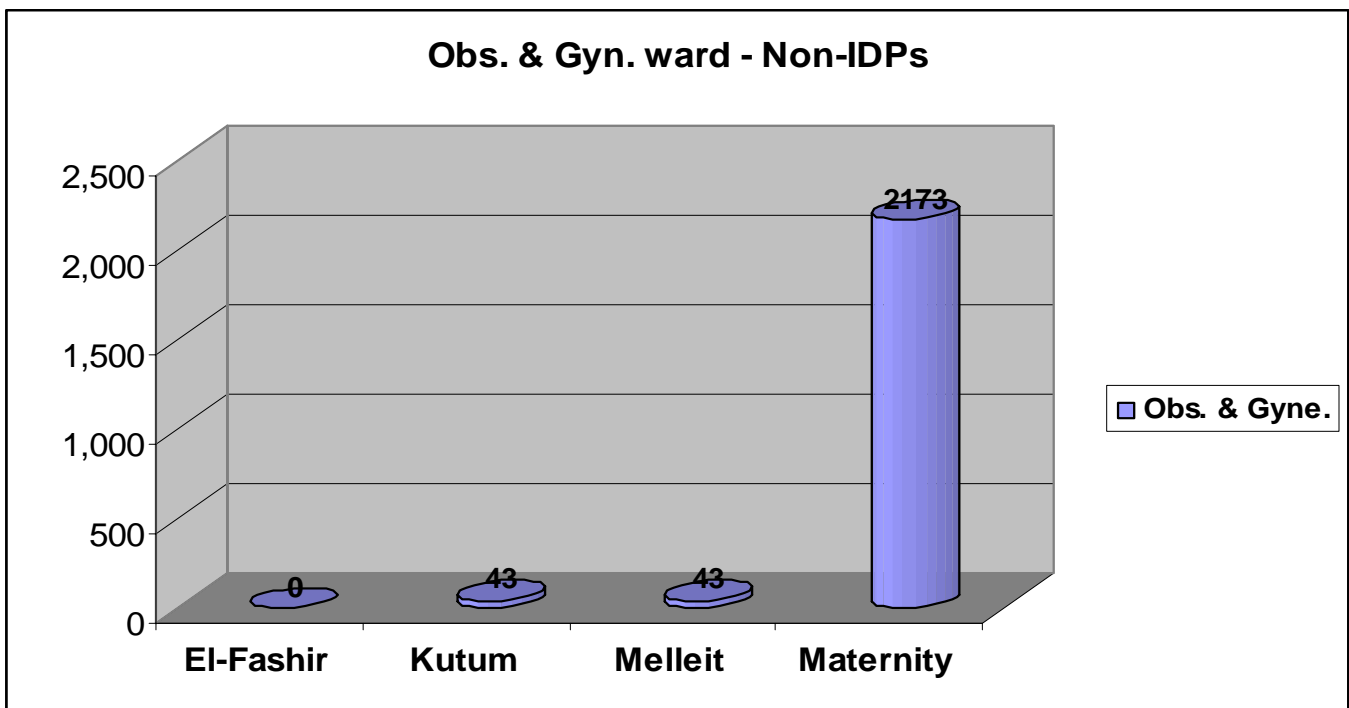
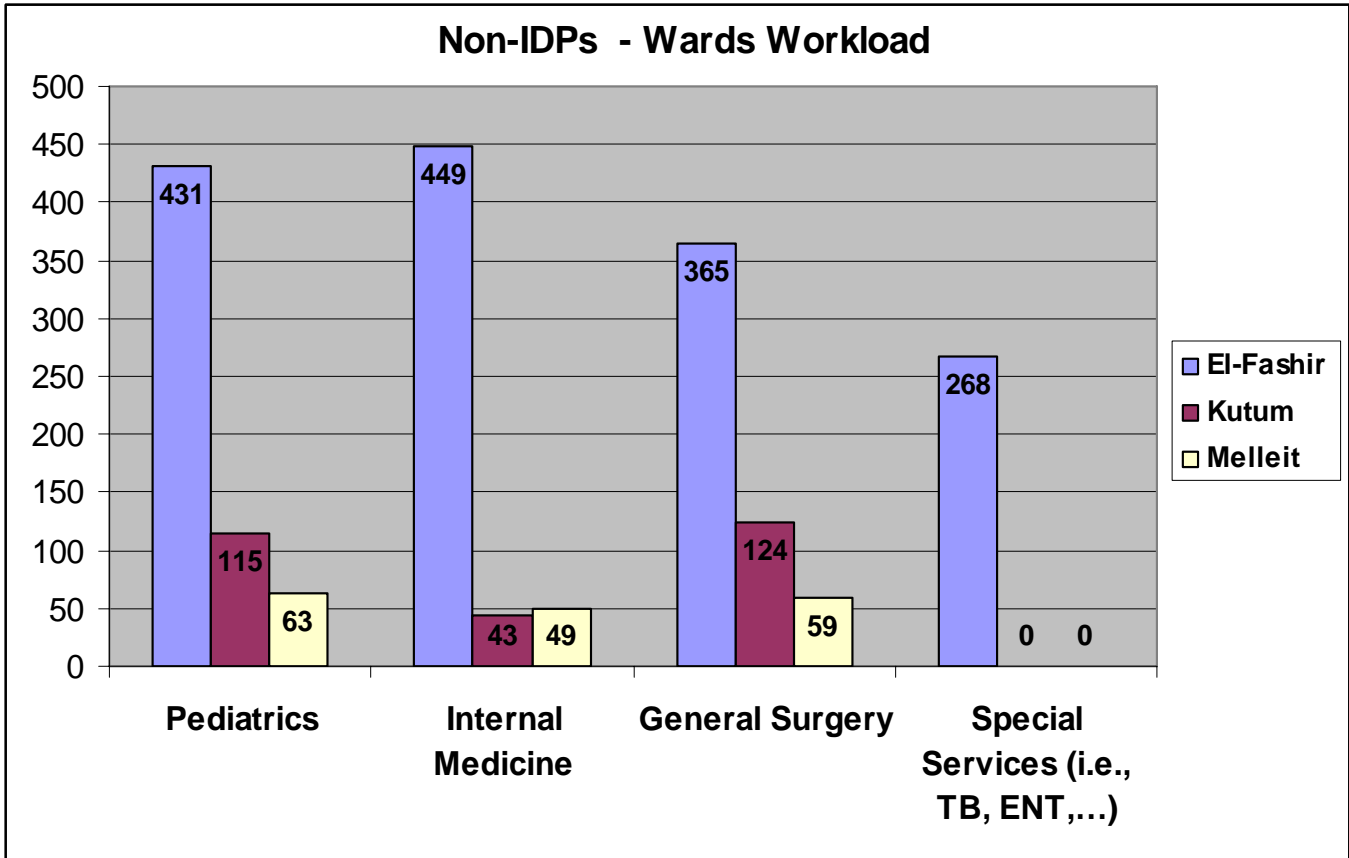
Wards Workload

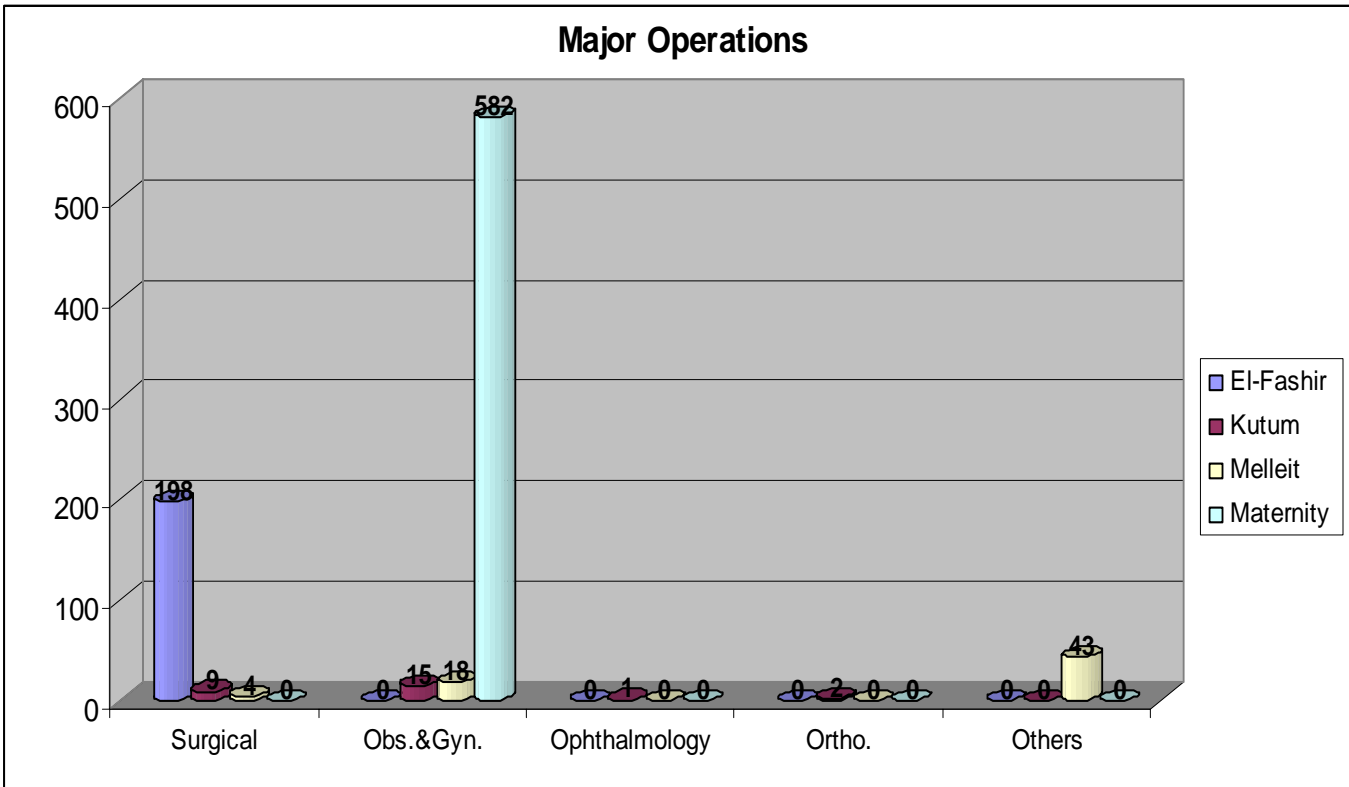
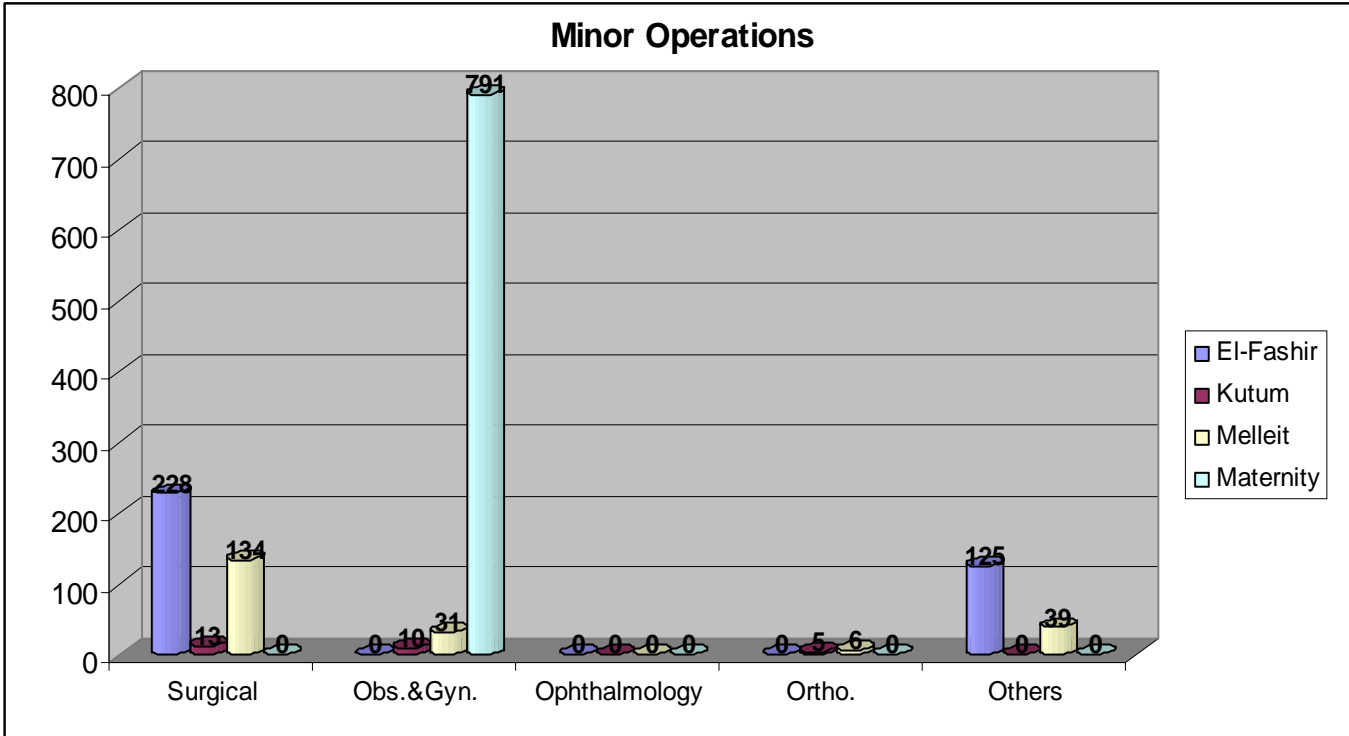
IDPs Wards Workload



Non-IDPs Wards Workload

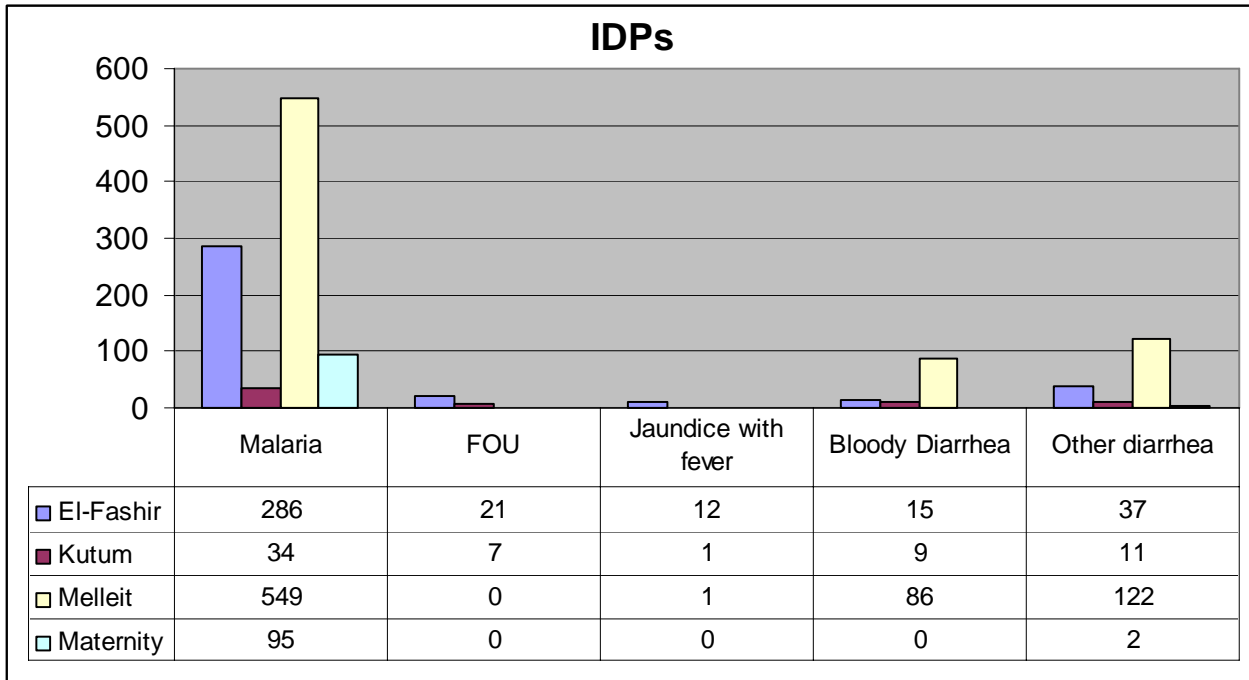

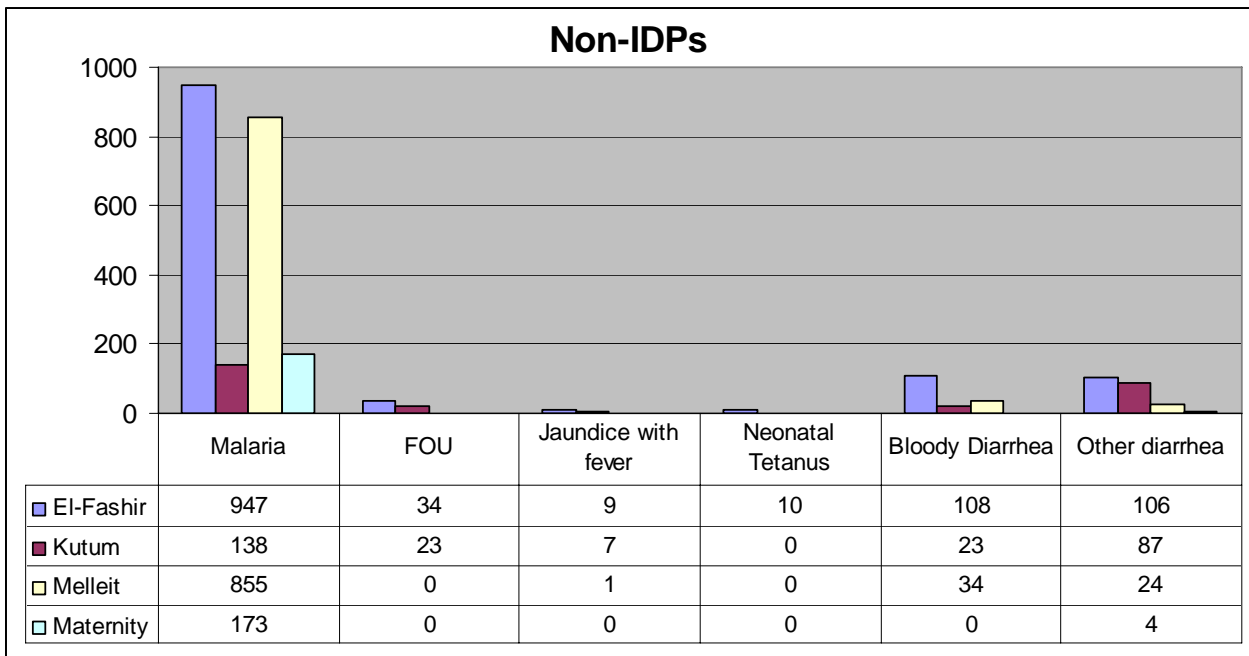


PATHOLOGICAL DIAGNOSIS FOR IDPs & NON-IDPs

Bloody Diarrhea, Other Diarrhea, Malaria, Measles, FOU, Meningitis, Jaundice with fever, Neonatal Tetanus

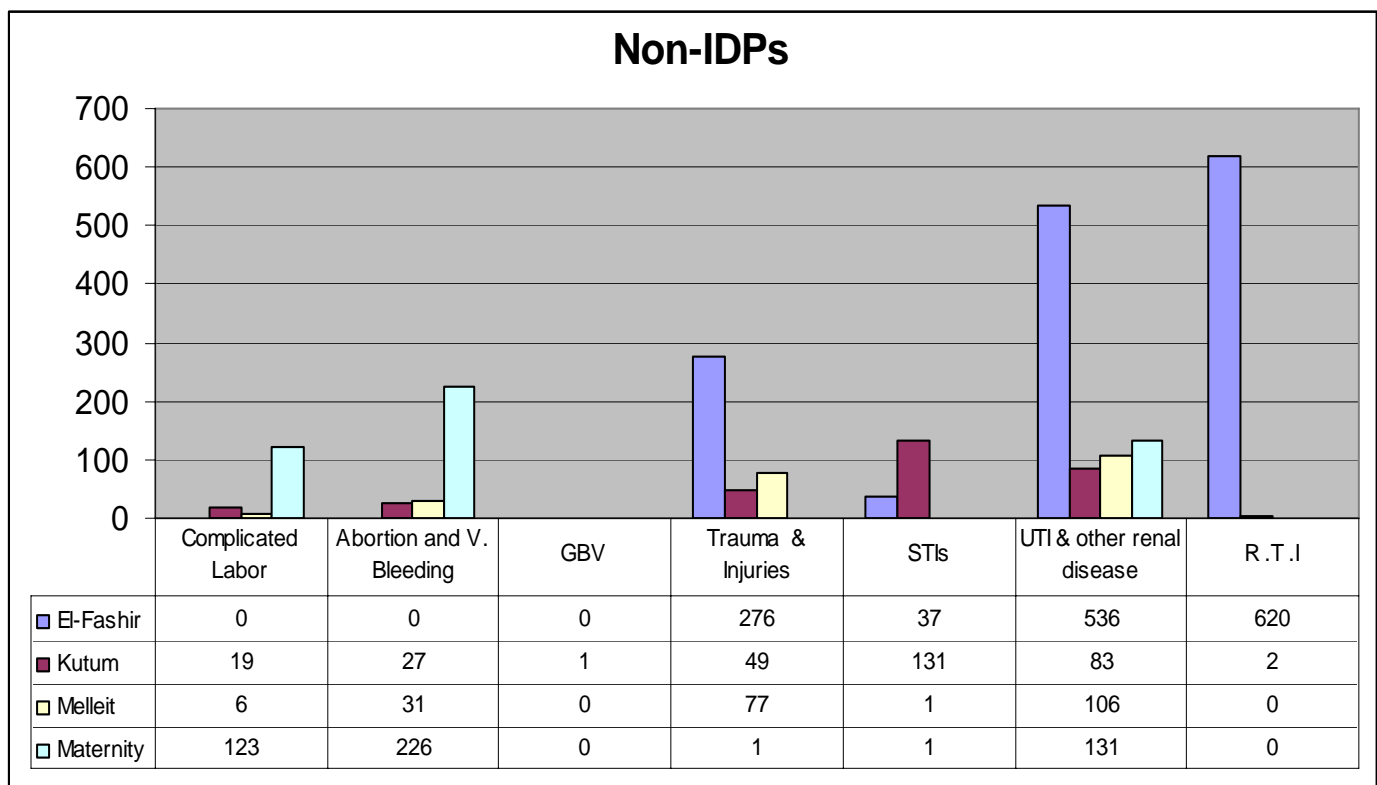
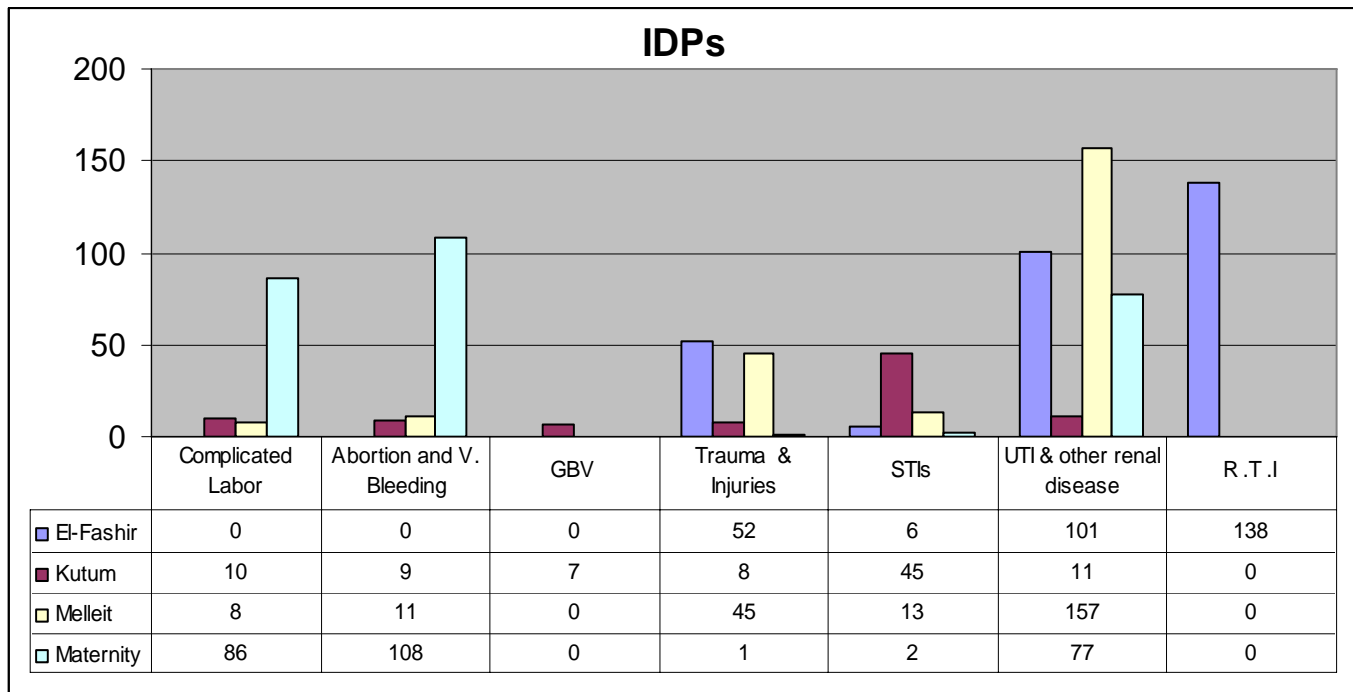
