From 25 February to 1 March 2018, a total of 30 workshop participants learned about the finer details of dealing with mass casualty incidents at the <u>Salam Centre for Cardiac Surgery</u> - such as large traffic accidents, explosions, or anything else that overwhelms the need of available medical services.
