Dr Renee began her career as a medical coordinator for Milecins Sans Frontiles Belgium (1994–1998) with postings to various countries, namely the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Sierra Leone, Chad, Rwanda and Chechnya. She went on to serve as a medical officer in the WHO Polio department (1998–2004).

She then moved to the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), initially as Chief of Health and Nutrition in Chad (2004–2006). Dr Renee went on to become Senior Health

Adviser (Child Survival) in various UNICEF locations (2006–2007) and then Chief of Maternal, Newborn and Child Health at the UNICEF headquarters in New York, USA

(2008–2013).
