
Medical evacuation of Gaza patients through Rafah Crossing



Top 5 destination countries for treatment

4,895 Patients evacuated (35%) out of 13,872

Around **2,150** patients unable to leave Gaza since 7 May 2024 due to closure of the Rafah Crossing

2,384 Egypt

- 970 Qatar
- 701 United Arab Emirates
- 430 Turkey
- 136 Algeria

WHO estimates that over **10,000** patients need medical evacuation outside Gaza for specialized care

Medical evacuation corridors must be urgently established for the sustained, organized, safe, and timely passage of critically ill patients from Gaza via all possible routes. This includes Rafah and Karem Shalom to Egypt, West Bank, East Jerusalem, and from there to other countries when needed.
