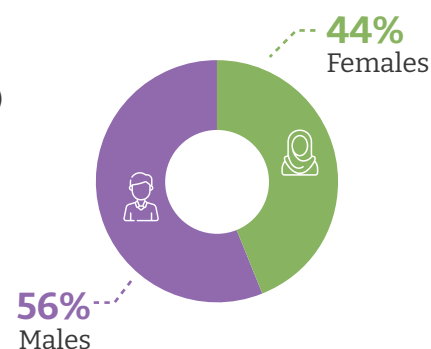
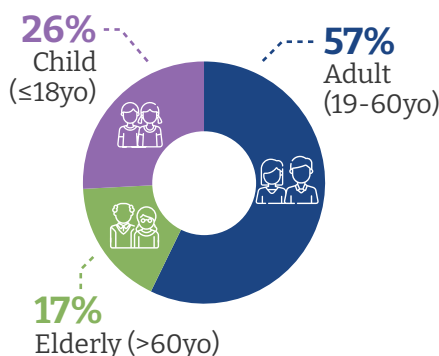

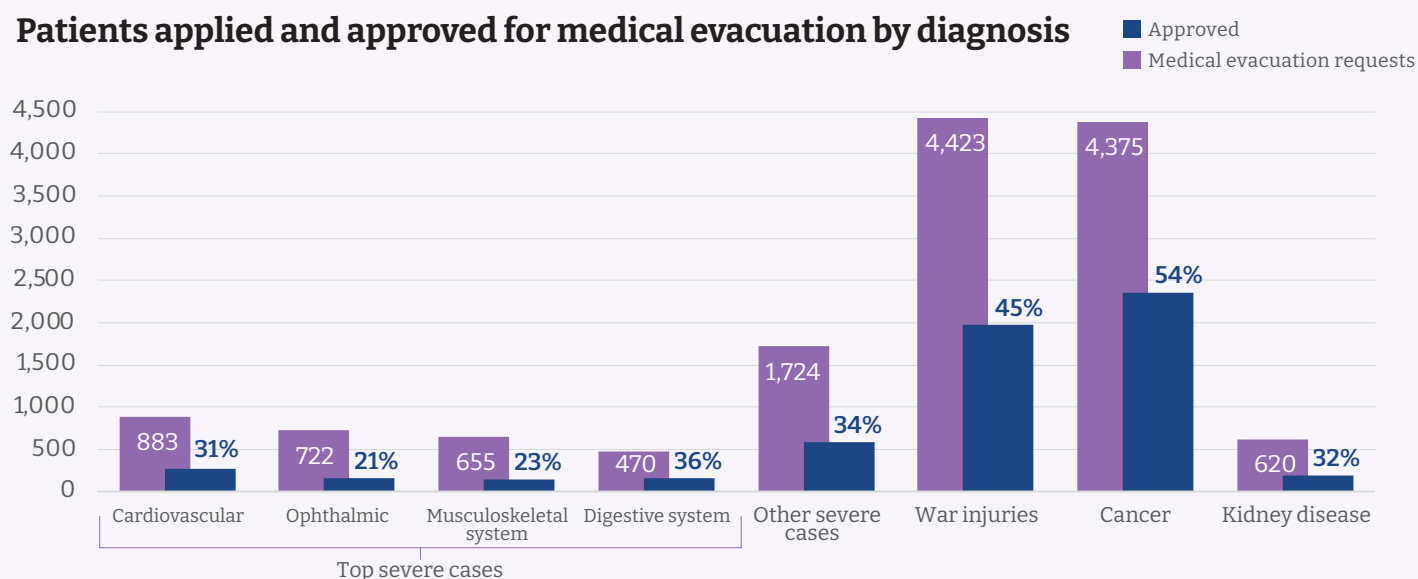
Patients applied for medical evacuation

(Lowest approval rate)

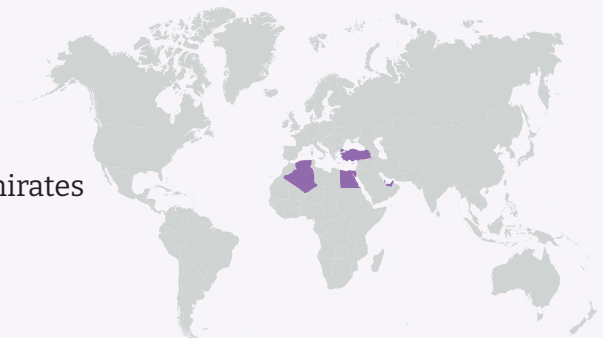


4,895 Patients evacuated

Around **2,150** patients unable to leave Gaza since 7 May 2024 due to closure of the Rafah Crossing

WHO estimates that over **10,000** patients need medical evacuation outside Gaza for specialized care



Medical evacuation corridors must be urgently established for the sustained, organized, safe, and timely passage of critically ill patients from Gaza via all possible routes. This includes Rafah and Karem Shalom to Egypt, West Bank, East Jerusalem, and from there to other countries when needed.
