

# Timeline for patient medical evacuations

7 Oct 23 - 6 May 24 (Pre Rafah crossing closure) Patients evacuated (7 Oct 23 - 31 July 25) including 5201 children **Total** patients 4034 Children 7 May 24 - 18 Jan 25 evacuated Via Kerem Shalom due to Rafah crossing closure 19 Jan - 17 Mar 25 (Ceasefire period) (90%)Patients evacuated by WHO support (100%) 48 Outside of WHO support 1702 Patients evacuated by 227 Children WHO support 1673 via Rafah crossing

18 Mar - 31 July 25 (Resumption of hostilities)


