COVID-19 Situation Report October 2022



EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION

- As of 31 October 2022, the Eastern Mediterranean Region (EMR) has reported 23 156 118 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 348 705 deaths since the start of the pandemic with the total number of tests reaching 437 903 767.
- During the reporting period, in comparison with the previous month¹:
- The number of cases has decreased by 31%
 - The number of deaths decreased by 58%
 - The number of conducted tests decreased by 29%
 - 5 countries reported an increase in cases²
 - 4 countries reported an increase in deaths²
 - 7 countries reported a simultaneous decrease in cases and deaths²
- To date, 20 EMR countries have reported the detection of the Omicron variant of concern (VOC) including 19 countries reporting the BA.1 sub-lineage, 16 countries reporting the BA.2 sub-lineage, 2 countries reporting the BA.3 sub-lineage, 9 countries reporting the BA.4 sub-lineage, and 9 countries reporting the BA.5 sub-lineage.



as of 31 October 2022






Graph 1: Weekly distribution of COVID-19 cases in the Eastern Mediterranean Region

REGIONAL RESPONSE HIGHLIGHTS

Operations Support and Logistics

- Remained on track to exceed outputs from 2021 through WHO's logistics hub in Dubai, United Arab Emirates with over US\$ 31 million in emergency health supplies delivered across all 6 WHO geographic regions.
- Published a highlight of the pillar's work in a video during the 69th session of the Regional Committee for the Eastern Mediterranean: https://youtu.be/iOxYKSjzSbY.

Health Information and Technical Expertise

Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)

• Reviewed and updated the national COVID-19 IPC guidelines and documents for Somalia and Djibouti.

Case Management and Clinical Operations

- Continued to expand oxygen scaling-up activities in the Region, collecting baseline oxygen data and contracting 15 national biomedical engineers in 9 countries in fragile and conflict-affected situations.
- Conducted a mission to Sudan to scale up the intensive care unit (ICU) and critical care in response to COVID-19. The mission team:
 - performed site assessments in selected ICUs in Sudan using available ICU assessment tools;
 - developed an ICU assessment tool for Sudan that is contextualized, easy to use, repeatable, and provides implementation recommendations;
 - recommended a process for the mapping of ICUs and critical care capacity in Sudan.
- Introduced a 9-week national critical care training in Yemen as part of the COVID-19 response. The training has been completed for 48 national experts in ICU/critical care and is currently ongoing in North Yemen.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Supported Sudan with around US\$ 3.6 million towards the national COVID-19 vaccination campaign.
- Finalized and submitted the COVID-19 vaccine delivery support "third fund" to Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance.
