Advancing countries' capacities on Evidence-Informed Policy-Making in an innovative, easy-to-use way: the web-based training package

In 2019, a landmark resolution was endorsed by the WHO Eastern Mediterranean Regional Office (WHO EMRO) to enhance the national institutional capacity for the use of evidence and data in policy-making for health of the countries in the region.

WHO introduced an integrated multi-concept approach that brought together different existing programmes and processes for evidence-informed policy-making (EIPM) under one umbrella. A regional action plan was developed in 2021 for the implementation of the resolution (https://apps.who.int/iris/handle/10665/352260).

Enhancing national technical capacity is one of the key areas identified in the regional action plan. Alongside organizing a series of region-wide and country-specific workshops and trainings on the the key aspects of EIPM, it was necessary to identify innovative approaches for responding to the countries growing interests in this area of work. Hence, as the first such platform globally, WHO EMRO searched and reviewed existing training packages for EIPM, under 13 thematic areas, and made them readily accessible through the Web-Based Training Package on EIPM.




Web-Based Training Package on EIPM
