

Summary Table by Province

Provincial Department of Health Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in collaboration with World Health Organization, Pakistan conducted a five-day Training on "Inpatient Management of Severe Acute Malnutrition in Children" from 20 to 24 December 2021 at VIP Guesthouse, Peshawar. Fifteen staff of the Nutrition Stabilization Centers at Lady Reading Hospital and Naseer Ullah Khan Babar Memorial Hospital Peshawar participated.

The objectives of the training were Capacity building of the Health Care Providers (HCPs), on inpatient management of severely malnourished children presenting with medical complications and Active involvement of the HCPs for providing nutrition services at hospital level, to ensure sustainability and ownership of the program. The WHO guidelines on the Management of Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM) in children were adapted for the training.

At the closing session Dr Ziad Ullah Shah head of Pediatric department and Dr Fakhar Uddin, MS Naseer Ullah Babar Memorial, hospital thanked WHO for conducting the training.
