

- Patches of stagnant water are still present in few UCs of district Naseerabad, district Jhal Magsi, district Jaffarabad/ Usta Mohammad and Sohbatpur.
- In Sindh Province, 87,422 people remain displaced, of these:
 6,152 people are in 04 tent cities, established by DDMAs/ Deputy Commissioners (PDMA Sindh, 26 Jan 2023)
- Outbreak of Malaria still remains a challenge in some of the return areas
- According to GIEWS, FAO on floods situation, the latest Integrated Food Security Phase Classification (IPC) analysis, carried out in 28 districts in Balochistan, Sindh and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa provinces prior to the floods in the first week of July, about 5.96 million people are projected to be facing high levels of acute food insecurity (IPC Phase 3 Crisis and above).
- Acute food insecurity levels are expected to increase in 2023 as livelihoods of many people have been disrupted by the floods



Number of Confirm Malaria Cases from Week 1, 2022 to Week 3 2023 (Source: DHIS-2/DMC)






🧶 WHO RESPONSE

- Mass Drug Administration (MDA) in Rajo Dero and Bhakkar Jamali. MDA will be conducted in 2 villages of Johi Taluka in district Dadu from 31st to 3rd February. 10,000 inhabitants, including pregnant women and children will benefit from this exercise.
- Distribution of Long-Lasting Insecticide Treated Bed Nets launched in • Bhakkar Jamali of Dadu district. More than ten thousand people will be protected.
- IRS for the remaining households in Sohbatpur town planned for February
- IRS and MDA planned for Zhob and Musakhail districts in Balochistan in the month of February
- In Sindh province, 76 labor rooms have been selected by WHO for strengthening through provision of essential equipment and supplies. 56 labor rooms in different health care facilities have now received the equipment's and supplies.
- In Balochistan, labor rooms from, 40 health facilities of 12 districts were targeted and out of these 18 have been provided with essential equipment's and supplies for the labor room room.
- WHO supported Nutrition Stabilization Centers (NSCs) in Sindh, KP • and Balochistan province have admitted 7,928 children with SAM with complication between Aug and Dec 2022. The cure rate recorded at the facility is above 90%.
