SITUATION OVERVIEW

Monitoring of Diseases Trend

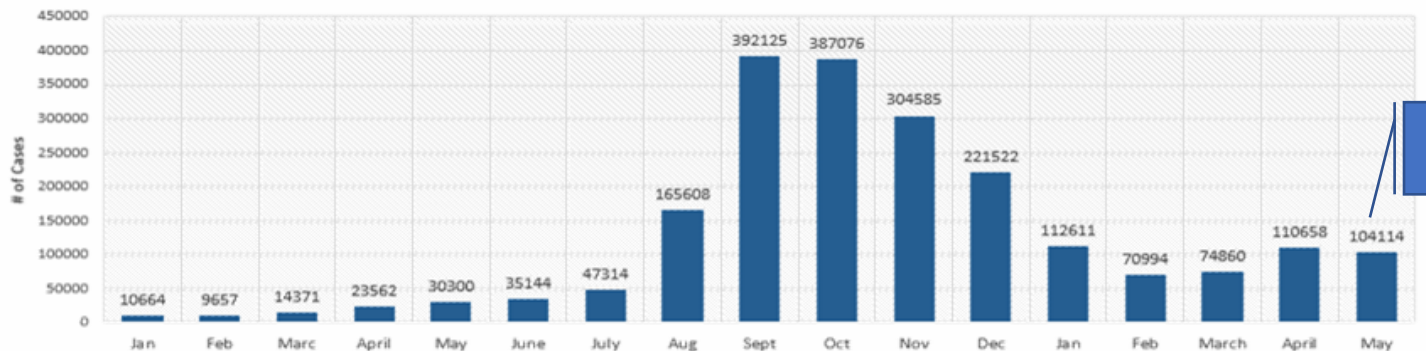
- In Pakistan the number of confirmed malaria cases is 43,587 as of epi-week 20 of 2023, compared to 31,166 cases as of epi-week 17. The test positivity rate for malaria in epi-week 17 was 18.6% as compared to test positivity rate of 27.6% in epi-week 20 of 2023. The most affected districts are from Baluchistan province followed by Sindh province.
- Pakistan reported the fifth case of MPOX on Monday, May 22, 2023, at Islamabad International Airport. All the 5 cases of MPOX are imported. The last case is admitted and is in a stable condition
- The COVID-19 positivity rate in Pakistan is <1% since 9th May 2023. Karachi (Sindh province) and Lahore (Punjab Province) are the most affected districts.

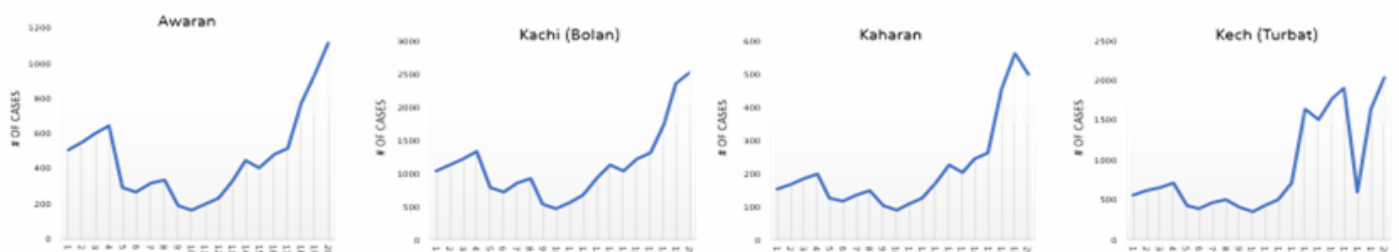

2nd Joint External Evaluation (JEE):

- The 2nd Joint External Evaluation (JEE) to assess Pakistan capacities to prevent, detect and rapidly respond to public health risks whether occurring naturally or due to deliberate or accidental events concluded on 25th May 2023. The JEE process included but not limited to country self-evaluation of the International Health Regulation (IHR) core capacities, field visits, meeting with national provincial leaderships, meetings with key partners and meeting with relevant government ministries.
- The country debriefing session was conducted on 25th May 2023 and attended by Special Assistant to The Prime Minister on Health Mr Mahesh Kumar Malani, Special Secretary for Health Mr. Mirza Nasir-ud-Din Mashhood, Provincial Minister P&SHD, Punjab Dr Jamal Nasir, Animal Husbandry Commissioner/IHR Focal point for animal health (AHC/NFSR) Dr Mohammad Akram, Director General Rescue 1122 Dr Rizwan Naseer, Representative of Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission, Dr Rana Iftikhar among others.
- The JEE was conducted with technical and financial support from WHO.

Support to response to malnutrition:

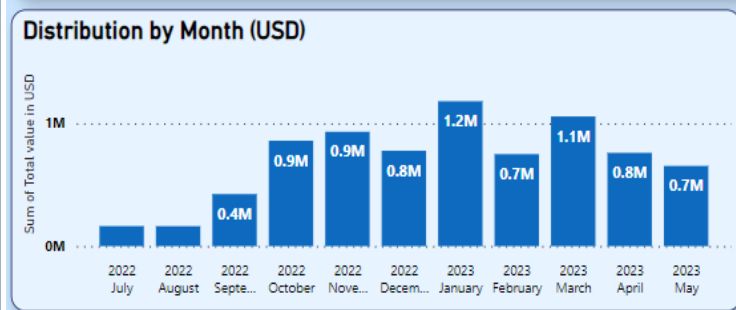
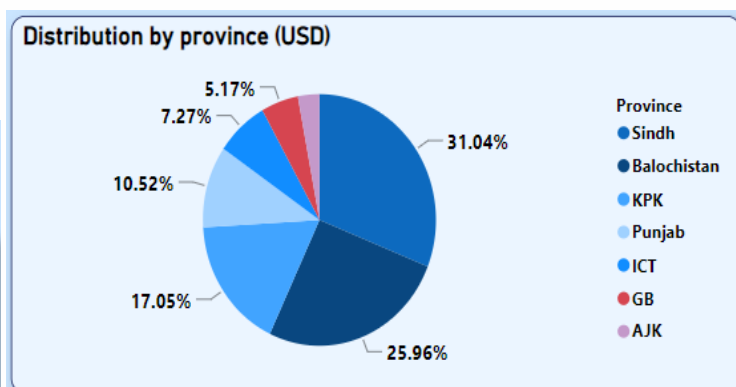
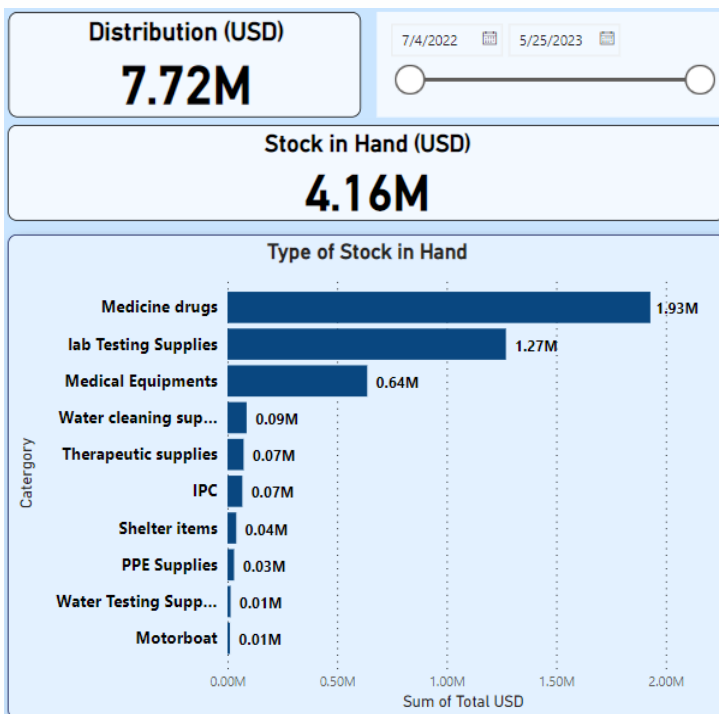
- As of epi-week 19 of 2023 over 18,848 children have been managed at the 72 WHO supported Nutrition Stabilization Centers (NSCs) in flood affected areas across Pakistan. The NSC performance indicators are 94.46% (16,113) children cured, 1.19% (203) children died, and 4.35% (742) children defaulted out of a total of 17,058 children. However, 1790 children are still in care.

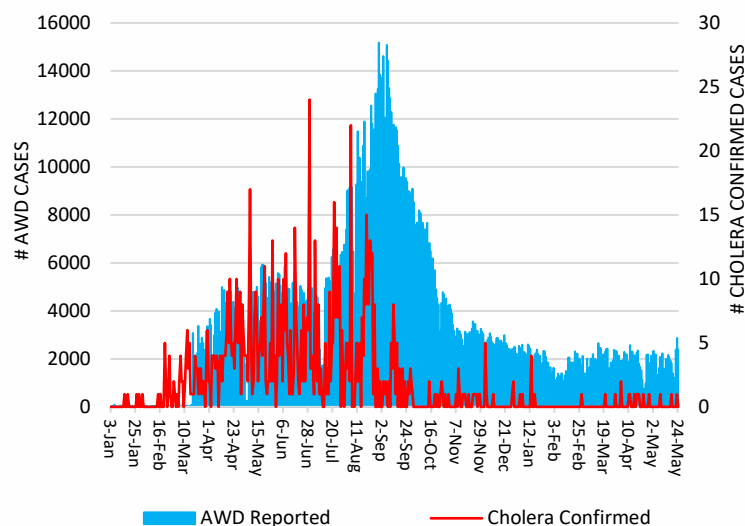

Daily AWD & Cholera Confirmed Cases Pakistan (3rd January 2022 till date)

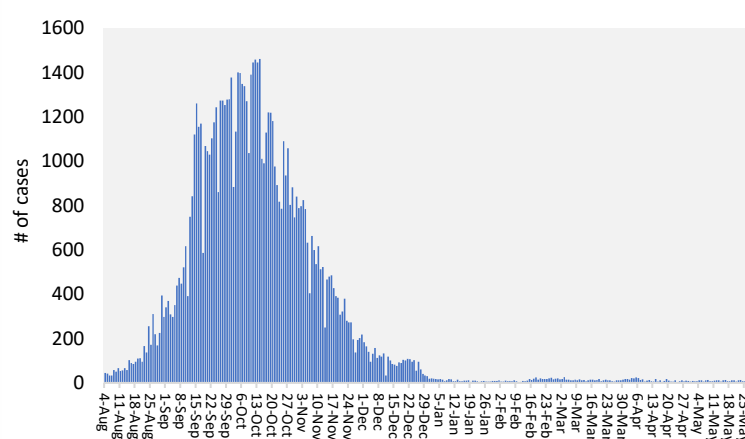

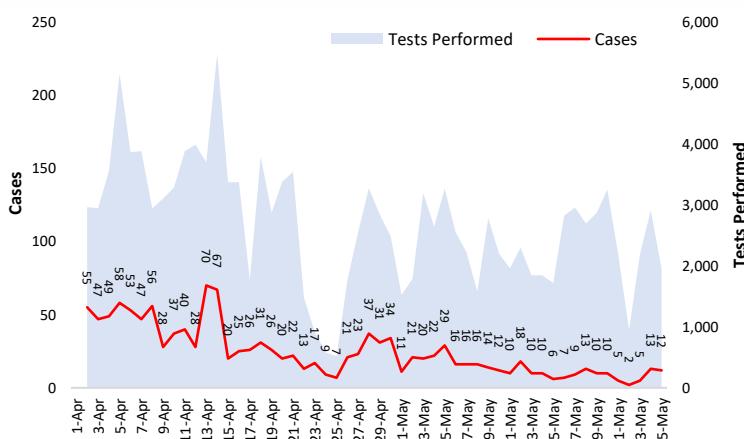
