SITUATION OVERVIEW

Monitoring of Diseases Trend

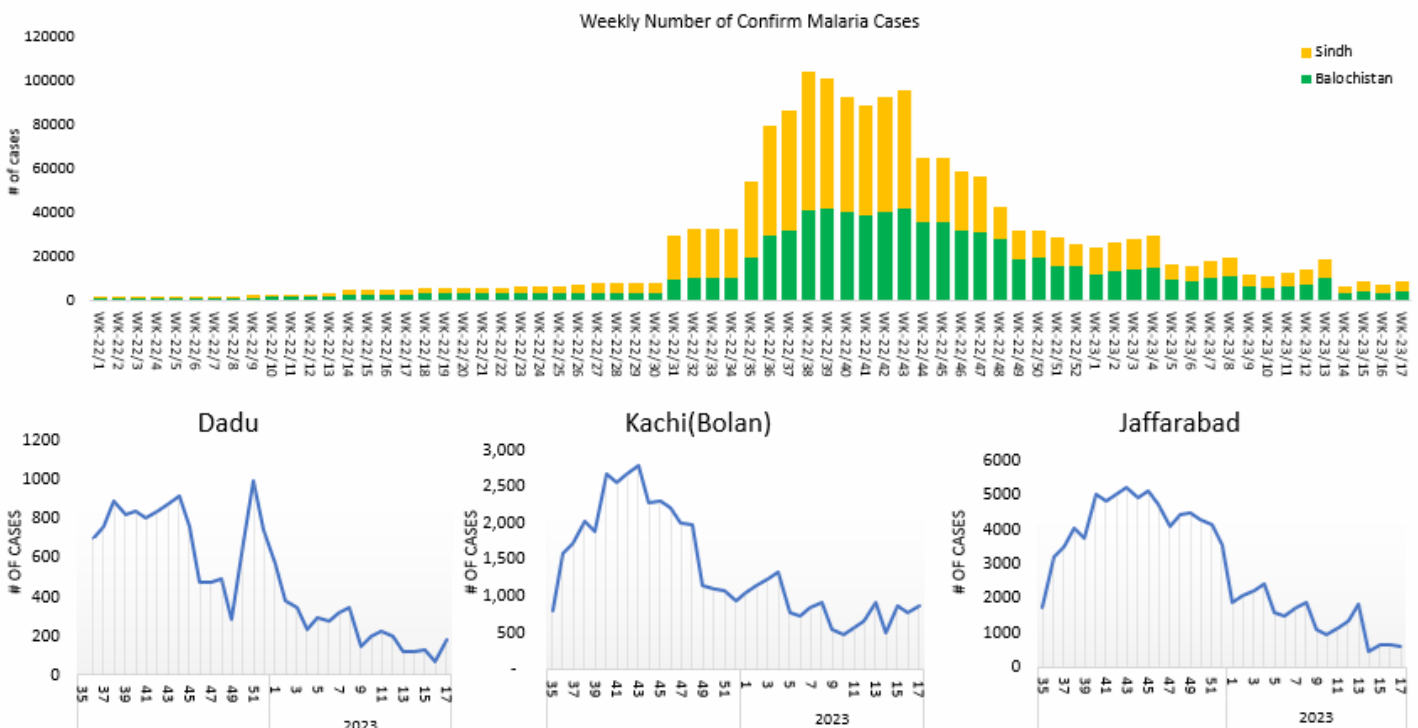
- Three imported cases of MPOX have been confirmed by the National Institutes of Health, Pakistan. 1st case was on 21st and the 3rd case was notified on 4th May 2023. All the cases are in isolation, 2 in hospital and one at home.
- COVID-19 positivity rate continues to decline in Pakistan. The positivity rate is 0.83% as of epi-week 18, down from 1.30% as of epi week 17 of 2023. Peshawar, Multan, Rawalpindi and Karachi are the most affected districts.
- The situation of malaria transmission is within normal endemicity thresholds in most of the outbreak-hit districts, however, in a few districts of Balochistan and Sindh the number of reported cases is on the increased due to "Spring Peak".

WHO RESPONSE

Support to Point of Entry for MPOX:

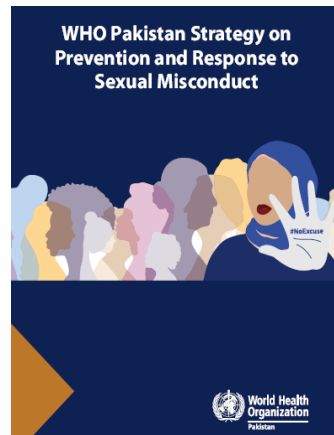
- On 3rd May 2023, WHO Country Representative Pakistan visited Islamabad International Airport to provide technical support to MPOX surveillance at the Point of Entry. During his meeting with Mr Syed Aftab Gilani the Chief Operating Officer, Islamabad airport, the WR appreciated the measures being implemented at the airport to identify and isolate suspected cases of MPOX. He emphasized on the need to enhanced coordination between the health staff, civil aviation, and other airport authorities. At the end of the visit, the WR handed over Infection Prevention & Control supplies and awareness-raising materials to the border health services officials.
- On 4th May 2023, National Institute of Health (NIH) in collaboration with WHO Pakistan conducted Training Workshop on MPOX Surveillance, Screening at PoE, Case Management, Risk Communication, Community Engagement and Education and Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) at Ramada Hotel, Islamabad. Over 70 participants included healthcare workers from border health services, health workers from health facilities in Islamabad and staff from district health office Islamabad attended the training.



A WHO team led by WR visited the Islamabad International Airport on 3rd May 2023 for monitoring traveler screenings.

Support to developed strategy on PRSM:

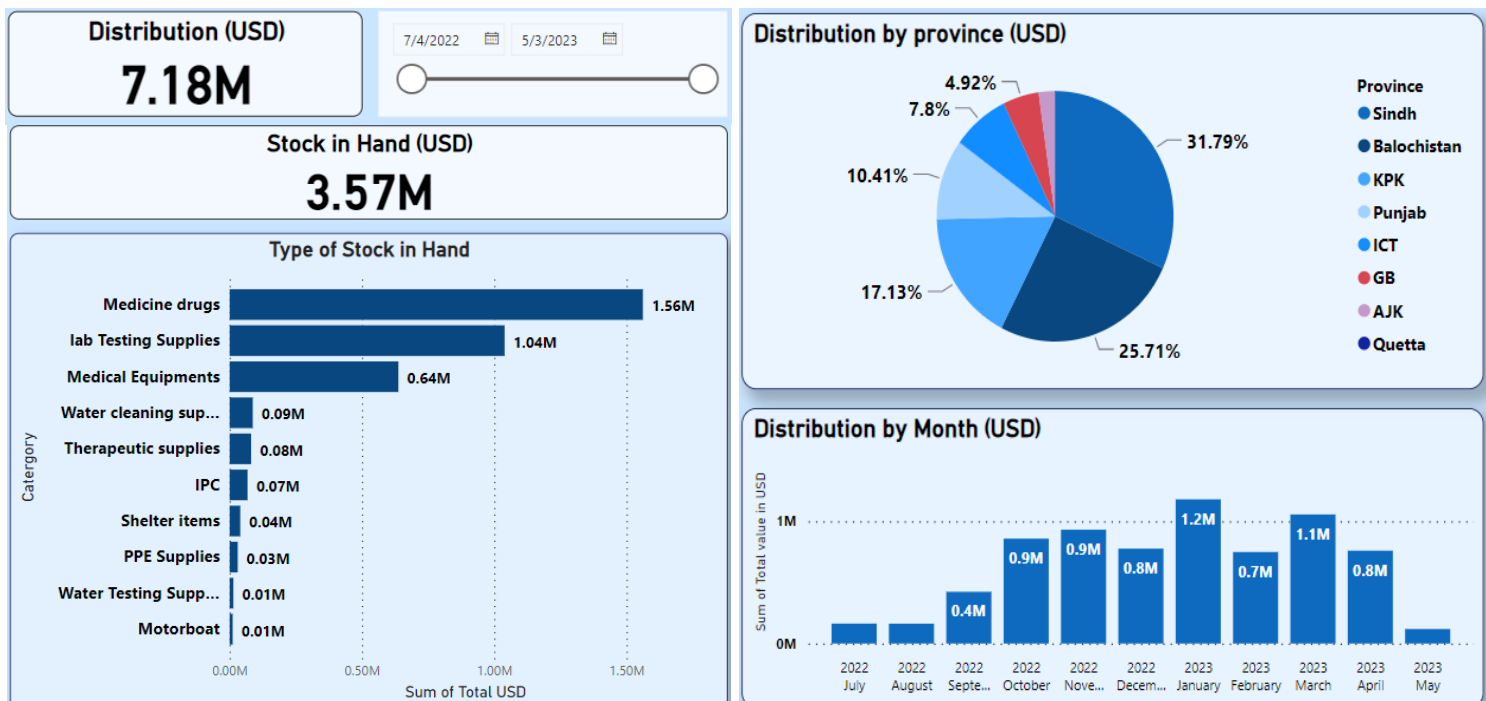
- WHO Pakistan has developed the first-ever strategy on Prevention and Response to Sexual Misconduct. The scope of this strategy is for staff, personnel, implementing partners, and collaborators of WHO Pakistan to prevent and address issues of Sexual Misconduct that constitute sexual exploitation, abuse, and harassment at all levels of operations and program delivery including in humanitarian settings and health emergencies. This strategy is aligned with global policy and the interagency standing committee (IASC) guidelines and standards of conduct.



Strategy on Prevention and Response to Sexual Misconduct

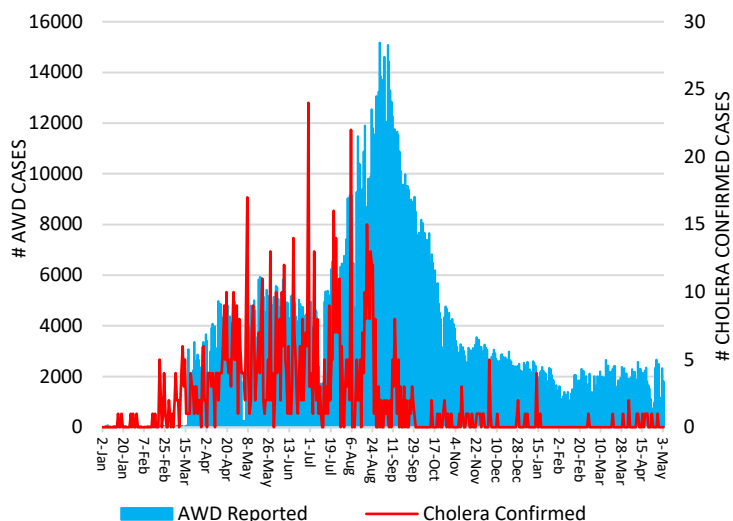

Daily AWD & Cholera Confirmed Cases Pakistan

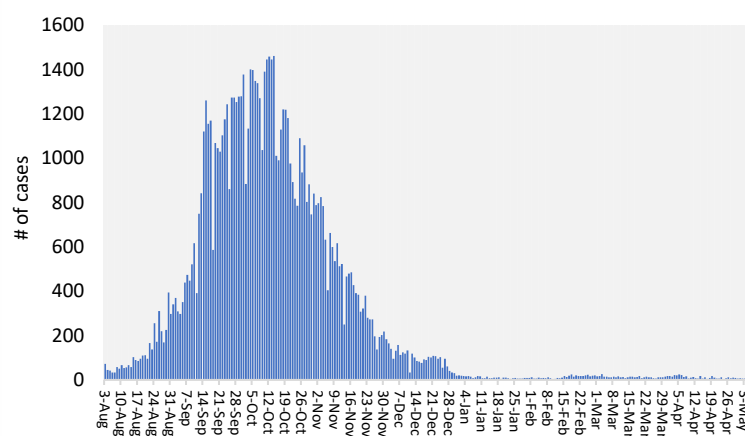

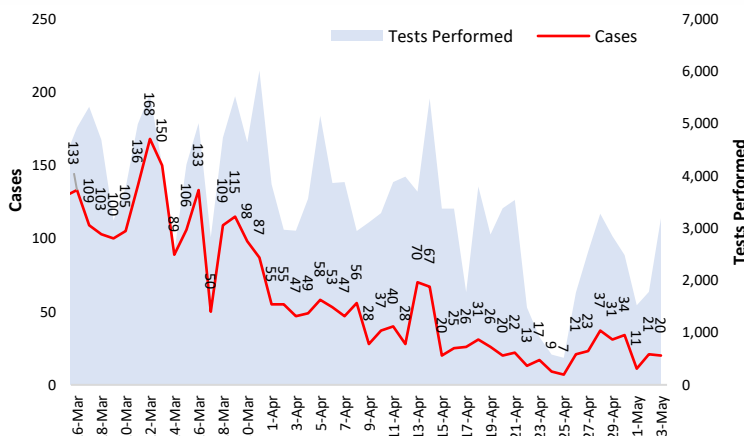
