• Population movement following floods.


- In Sindh Province, currently 5,132 people are still living in 1 operational tent city in the district Malir.
- In Balochistan Province, currently no displaced population related to flood emergency, reported by PDMA Balochistan.
- Monitoring Diseases Trend in flood affected districts.
 - The COVID-19 positivity rate decreased to 1.3% from 3.05% in the Epi week 10. In Karachi, Mardan Peshawar and Islamabad the COVID-19 positivity rate is still high as compared to other major cities.
 - There is need to continue monitoring the disease trends as the risk of resurgence of water and vectorborne disease remains high

PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERNS





• Support to RMNCAH services:

 The first Caesarian section performed at the DHQ hospital Naseerabad Balochistan almost after a decade. WHO recently supported the hospital with renovation, equipment and deployment of Obstetrician/Gynecologist and Anesthetist to strengthen the services. The WHO supported consultants performed the surgery. The Deputy Commissioner Naseerabad visited the hospital and appreciated the work of WHO Pakistan and the Department of Health Balochistan.

• Support to Nutrition Services:

- A total of 13,113 children have been treated at the WHO supported Nutrition Stabilization Centers (NSCs) in flood affected areas across Pakistan to date. Performance indicators for these NSCs are within sphere standards with 93.23% children cured, 1.54% died and 5.23% defaulted.
- WHO's Supported Medical Relief Camps:
 - WHO supported Medical Camps in flood-affected areas of Balochistan through Balochistan Rural Support Program (BRSP). The Medical camps will provide general OPD services catering to diarrhea, ARI, malaria, and skin diseases and other patients. They will also ensure primary healthcare services including maternal and child healthcare services, nutrition, routine immunization, and health education.




Childbirth after Caesarean Section performed at DHQ Hospital Naseerabad Balochistan

WHO support for flood Response (as of 7th April 2023).


