



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.





Pakistan reported 3,499 new cases of COVID-19 on 02 December 2020. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 406,810 with 8,205 deaths (CFR: 2.02%). Out of the total 51,654 currently active cases 3,005 cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Today, 03 December 2020, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala participated in the World Disability Day celebration at parliament house, Islamabad. Other participants included Members of National Assembly, Parliament caucus, UN agencies, Civil Societies and NGOs. During his speech, Dr Palitha mentioned that WHO recognizes disability as a global public health issue, a human rights issue and a development priority. WR emphasized on the importance of mainstreaming disability inclusion across all dimensions; population, services, and direct cost of healthcare, to ensure that no one is left behind.

WHO being the lead agency for disabilities among the UN Agencies/organization is supporting the Government at the federal and provincial level in formulating disability legislation, Disability Strategic Action Framework, adapt and translate disability guidelines in local languages, promoting Community Based Rehabilitation and improving disability data reliability and comparability in the country.
