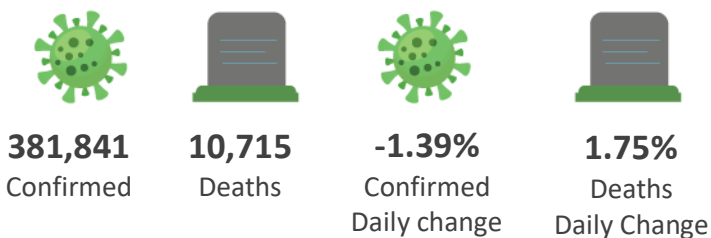


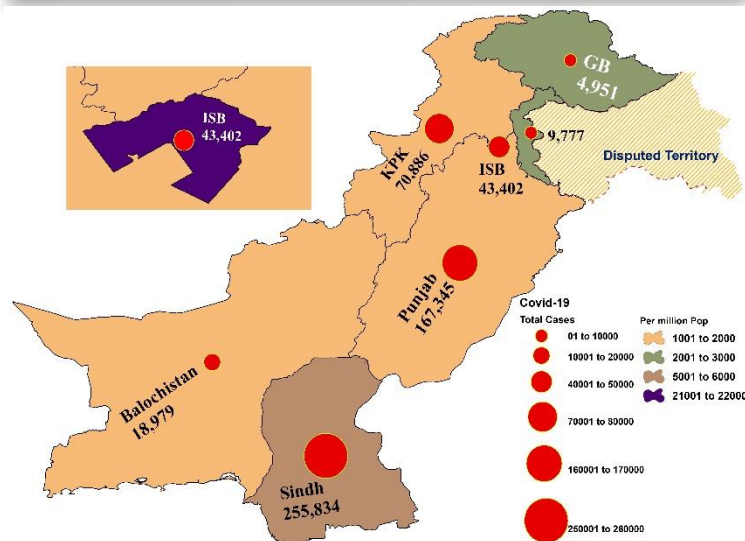

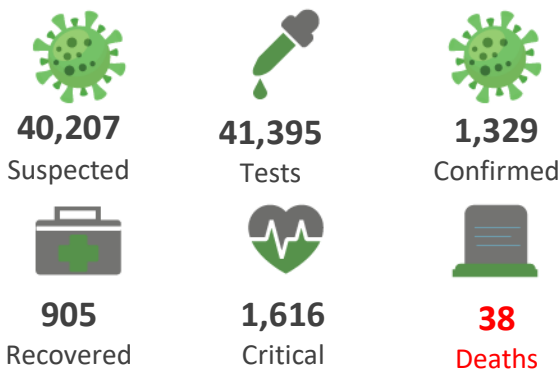


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



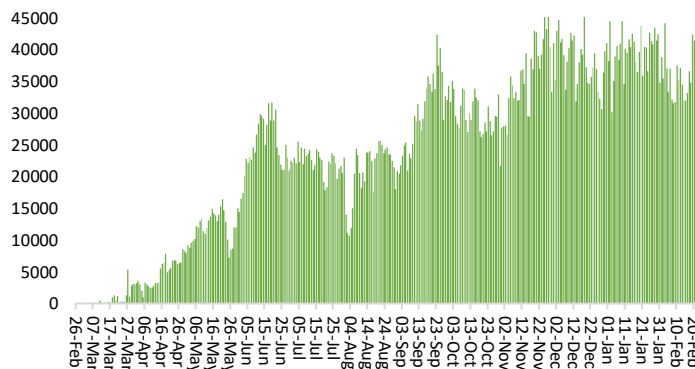
Pakistan reported **1,329** new cases of COVID-19 on **20th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **571,174** with **12,601** deaths (**CFR: 2.21%**). Out of the total **24,466** currently active cases **2,053** cases are hospitalized.

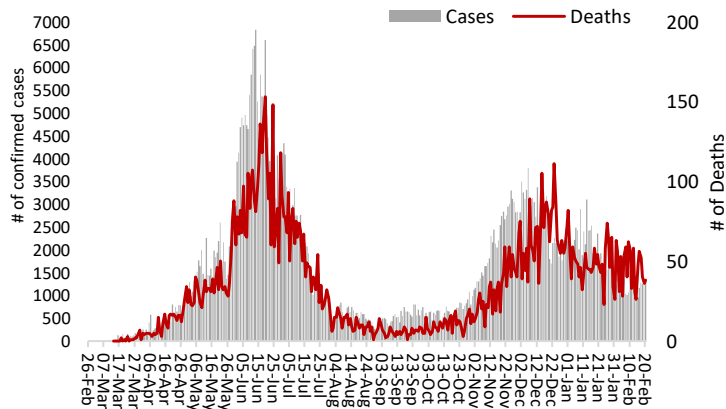
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

26-Feb 2020 to 20-Feb 2021

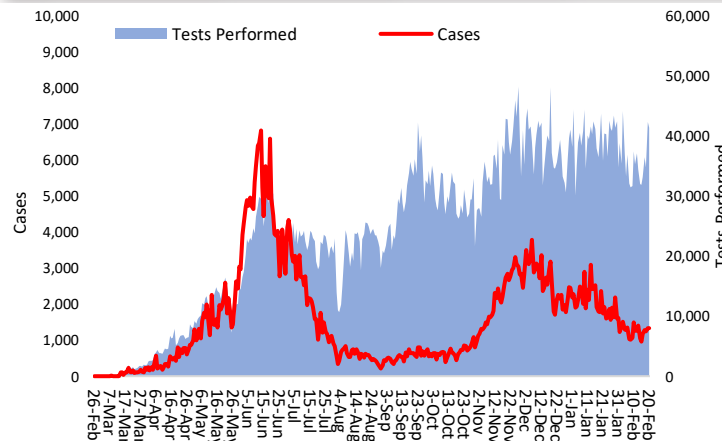


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 20th February 2021, the WHO Country Representative in Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited I-11 sector, Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) to monitor the progress of the ongoing Typhoid Vaccination campaign. He was accompanied by Director General Health Services Metropolitan Corporation Islamabad (MCI), Dr Hasan Orooj, WHO Team Lead EPI, Dr Osama Mere and National Program Manager EPI, Dr Akram Shah. This first phase of the Typhoid Conjugate Vaccine (TCV) campaign in Pakistan started on 2nd February 2021. The campaign is being conducted at the Federal capital territory and 12 districts in Punjab province.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr Palitha appreciated the efforts of the Federal government, District administration of ICT, and other campaign partners for delivering a successful campaign. He also appreciated the commitment and dedication of frontline health workers.
