HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately half of the new cases are Saudi nationals, and a third are females.
- 50,000 workers have been shifted to 2,000 new buildings.
- MoH has received 423 research proposals from academic institutions to participate in COVID19 Research.
- Mosques except in Makkah and Jeddah to open 40 minutes before Friday prayer.
- Resumption of professional sporting activities from June 21.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19.
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission: transmission is known to occur by symptomatic cases (infected people with symptoms) and pre-symptomatic cases (who later develop symptoms). More data is still needed about transmission via asymptomatic cases (who never develop symptoms). See link below.
