#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 39% of the new cases are female and 61% are male.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Hufuf (160), Makkah (122), Riyadh (108), Madina (83), Dammam (70), Yanbu (55), Jazan (51) and Abha (49).
- The MoH assigned a health leader for every 50 pilgrims during Hajj and dedicated paths for each group at Grand Mosque.
- Hajj security forces arrested 244 people who were attempting to infiltrate into the holy sites to perform Hajj in contravention of the coronavirus precautionary measures.
- Volunteers perform a trial Tawaf to ensure that all guidelines and precautionary measures including social distancing can be followed in Hajj 2020.
- No cases of Coronavirus infection have been recorded so far between the pilgrims.
