HIGHLIGHTS

- 45% of the new cases are female and 12% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Riyadh (88), Dammam (65), Hufuf (63), Hail (62), Buraidah (59), Makkah (58), Jeddah (52), and Madina (51).
- 3,984 inspection tours during the first week of August in Eastern Province to ensure commercial entities are following COVID-19 precautionary measures.
- 90% is the rate of Riyadh recovered cases.
- The Riyadh Global Digital Health Summit will be launched today aiming to discuss the role of digital health to mitigate the impact of COVID-19 on the healthcare system.
- COVID-19 recovery rate in GCC countries reached 90%.
