HIGHLIGHTS

• 43% of the new cases are female and 11% are children.

• Cities with highest new infections were: Rivadh (78), Hail (75), Makkah (68), Jeddah (66), Madina (60), Khamis Meshait (57), Dammam (52), Hufuf (50), and Yanbu (48).

• The Riyadh Global Digital Healthcare Summit ends with a declaration calling for the sharing of digital healthcare practices and data to help the world fight the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

• Health Minister: Saudi Arabia gives top priority to confront epidemics during its G20 presidency.

 Minister of Education: financial allocations would continue for scholarship students who are in Saudi Arabia during the COVID-19 pandemic period and who are pursuing their studies remotely. 237 violations in Al Qassim and Jazan were recorded for individuals not wearing face mask.
