### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 45% of the new cases are female and 10% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Jazan (109), Makkah (106), Madina (57), Jeddah (56), Hafr AlBatin (52), Riyadh (49), Hufuf (48), Sabya (45) and Abha (44).
- Daily reporting of confirmed cases decline from its peak two months ago by 72%, while critical cases decrease by 25%.
- Saudi Arabian Monetary Authority (SAMA) awards "heroes for health" medals in appreciation of the efforts made by frontline health workers.
- Ministry of Trade inspection teams conduct over 3,500 inspection visits over the past three weeks and recorded 82 violations, around 98% compliance with mitigation measures.
