- Out of newly confirmed cases, 44% are female and 11% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Makkah (84), Hail (60), Jeddah (58), Sabya (53), Madinah (51), Abu Arish (48), Baish (37), Samtah (37), Riyadh (37) and Jazan (33).
- MoH launches a new drive through "Ta'kkad" COVID-19 testing facility in the south of Riyadh.
- Municipality: 29 shopping malls violated COVID-19 mitigation measures in Asir Region.


