- Out of newly confirmed cases, 43% are female and 11% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Makkah (74), Jazan (56), Jeddah (54), Khamis Mushait (53), Riyadh (51), Madinah (43), Al Qunfutha (39), Sabya (38) and Dammam (34).
