HIGHLIGHTS

- with less than 1,000 new infections, Saturday marks the lowest number of new infections since 134 days.
- Of the new cases, 43% are female and 10% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections over the past 3 days were: Makkah (208), Riyadh (165), Jazan (149), Madinah (143), Tabouk (128), Jeddah (126), Sabya (109), and Hufuf (105).
- Tetamman clinics reach 323 clinics across the country, and so far have served over 900,000 individuals.
- SaudiVax in collaboration with international partners conducts research to develop a COVID-19 immunoglobulin.
