#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 43% of the new cases were female and 9% children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Makkah (81), Jeddah (72), Madinah (50), Hufuf (46), Riyadh (46), Taif (42), Mobarraz (33) and Hail (30).
- A joint committee in Tabouk composed of MoH, Municipality and Ministry of Interior staff and volunteers conducts over 7,000 inspections in August.
- COVID-19 services: over 16.7 million calls to the 937 hotline; over 2.28 million PCR tests conducted through Taakkad Centres; and over 970 thousand beneficiaries visited Tattmman clinics.
