HIGHLIGHTS

• In 2 days 43.5 % of the new cases were female and 10% children.

• Daily infections drop below 800 for the first time in 5 months.

• Cities with highest new infections over the past 3 days were: Madinah (178), Makkah (161), Jeddah (144), Dammam (139), Hufuf (126), Riyadh (116), Dhahran (85), and AlMubarraz (76).

• Saudi Airlines sets coronavirus guidelines for arriving travellers, including self-isolating for 1 week when flights are resumed.

• The washing ceremony of the Holy Kaaba was held following

intensive precautionary measures to prevent spread of COVID-19.Recovery rate of COVID-19 reaches 92.5% in the Kingdom and


