#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 43% of the new cases were female and 10% children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Dammam (54), Makkah (51), Jeddah (45), Hufuf (40), Riyadh (40), Madinah (37), Yanbu (36), Arar (33), Al Qatif (30) and Al Mubarraz (28).
- Minister of Health: The resumption of international flights is subject to the spread of Coronavirus cases.
- The Tawakalna application provides new features to reduce the risk of spread of COVID-19.
- MoH: a second wave of spread of the virus has not been detected.
