- Saudi Arabia's Embassy in Manila to begin receiving work visa applications from September 21.
- Saudi Arabia announced supporting the UN response plan to fight COVID-19 with \$100 million.
- The Kingdom achieves second place in the speed of PCR test results among G20 Countries.
- Recovery rate from Coronavirus reached 94% in the Kingdom and 92.7 in GCC countries.
