HIGHLIGHTS

- On 22nd of September, 41% of the new cases were female and 9% children.
- Cities with highest new infections in the past 2 days were: Makkah (128), Jeddah (117), Hufuf (80), Madinah (70), Riyadh (67), Dammam (60), Mubarraz (36), and Hail (35).
- Flights to repatriate deported Indians: one left from Jeddah on 23rd of September with 231 on board, another scheduled for 26th of September for 351 deportees.
- Umrah to be resumed on 4th of October for worshipers residing in the Kingdom with a limit of 6,000 pilgrims/day, an application to take necessary permissions will be launched on 27th of September.
