




HIGHLIGHTS

- Cities with highest new infections were: Jeddah (61), Makkah (53), Madinah (46), Hufuf (35), Riyadh (35), Yanbu (34), Khamis Mushait (21), and Hail (21).
- Umrah registration for the first 10 days has been completed, a total of 6,000 pilgrims will be allowed per day divided into 12 groups.
- COVID-19 recovery rate reaches 95.3% while case fatality rate reaches 1.4%.
